

STORM DAMAGE INSPECTION CHECKLIST

STAY SAFE FIRST

- Don't climb on the roof or enter unsafe areas.
- Watch for downed power lines, broken glass, and flooding.
- Document damage from the ground until it's safe to inspect up close.

DOCUMENT EVERYTHING

- Take photos and videos of all visible damage (interior and exterior).
- Capture close-ups and wide shots for context.
- Note the date, time, and type of storm (hail, wind, rain, etc.).

INSPECT KEY AREAS

- Roof: Missing shingles, hail dents, or flashing damage.
- Siding: Cracks, chips, or holes.
- Windows & Doors: Broken glass, seal failure, or water leaks.
- Gutters & Downspouts: Bent or detached sections.
- Ceilings & Walls: Water stains or bubbling paint.
- Yard & Surroundings: Damaged fences, trees, or exterior structures.

PREVENT FURTHER DAMAGE

- Cover broken windows or roof sections with tarps.
- Turn off water if leaks are detected.
- Keep receipts for any temporary repairs or materials.

REVIEW YOUR INSURANCE POLICY

- Check your deductible, exclusions, and coverage limits.
- Note filing deadlines for your claim.
