

Terms and conditions for GCSE maths revision programme 2024-5

1. Definitions

In these Terms and Conditions, the following terms will have the following meanings:

"You", "Your"	The Client i.e., the person or persons for which the Tutor provides tutoring services. This will be the Student where the Student is over 18 years old or the Parent or Guardian of a student, where the Student is less than 18 years old.
"We", "Us", "Our"	Mathematical Minds Tuition Limited, a company incorporated in England and Wales with company number 13284871 whose registered office address is 7 Nesfield Grove, Hampton in Arden, Solihull, West Midlands B92 0BQ.
"Tutor"	The person carrying out the Tuition Services.
"Tuition Services"	Agreed services to be carried out by the Tutor: GCSE maths revision programme 2024-5 comprising of Summer Sessions, October half term sessions, February half term sessions, Easter holiday sessions and Exam prep sessions.
"Content"	Anything provided by Us to You as part of the Tuition Services e.g. live event, recording of live event, PDF worksheet / answers etc.

2. General

- We reserve the right to alter these Terms and Conditions.
- These Terms and Conditions are governed by the law of England and Wales and the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.
- No variation or alteration of these Terms and Conditions by You shall be valid unless approved in writing by Us.
- Each party acknowledges that these Terms and Conditions govern legal rights and obligations between them.

3. Our responsibilities

- Plan and deliver online tuition sessions following the proposed content schedule for GCSE maths revision programme 2024-5.
- Provide a recording of the session to each attendee, after the session is complete.
- Provide PDF worksheet on topics covered in the session plus answers for self-marking to each attendee, after the session is complete.

4. Your responsibilities

- Agree to not give access to or transfer the contents of the session to another person who has not registered for it, in line with the requirements of section 5 'Licence' of these Terms and Conditions.
- Pay for the online tuition sessions in advance in full, in line with the requirements of section 6 'Payment' of these Terms and Conditions.
- Accept and adhere to the requirements of section 7 'Cancellations' and section 8 'Missed Sessions' of these Terms and Conditions
- Accept and adhere to all other requirements as set out in these Terms and Conditions.

5. Licence

When You register and pay for the online tuition sessions, We will grant You and the Student a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable licence to access, participate in and use the relevant Content for Your and the Student's personal, non-commercial purposes. The licence granted does not give You or the Student any rights in Our Content (including any material that We may licence from third parties).

The licence granted to You and the Student is subject to the following usage restrictions and/or permissions:

- Neither You nor the Student may copy, rent, sell, publish, republish, share, broadcast or otherwise transmit Our Content (or any part of it) or make it available to the public except as permitted under the Copyright Designs and Patents Act 1988 (Chapter 3 'Acts Permitted in relation to Copyright Works'); and
- When You or the Student use any two way livestream facility to access Our Content or event You and the Student must
 not communicate or make accessible to any other person (who also accesses or participates in it as one of Our
 customers) anything (by voice, text, image or otherwise) except for a query about or contribution to that Content or event
 which is proper having regard to the content of it.

You must ensure that the Student complies with the above restrictions, and You will be responsible to Us if he/she fails to do so as if it were You that had failed to do so.

We will not be liable for any loss or damage arising directly or indirectly from any act or omission of the Tutor. We can give no warranty, representation or undertaking as to the suitability, honesty or capability of any Tutor nor as to the completeness, truthfulness or accuracy of any information or statement or reference provided by Us or on Our behalf in respect of the Tutor. Verification of all such information and references shall be Your responsibility.

In no circumstances shall Our total liability to You, whether in respect of goods or services and whether based in negligence, breach of contract, misrepresentation or otherwise, exceed the fee payable by You.
