ENROLLMENT FEE

<u>\$125.00</u> — Payable at Registration. Each new student must pay this enrollment fee, which is not refundable. If a student withdraws and later re-enters, the enrollment fee must be paid again. This does not apply to regular students who take off during the summer.

BOOK PRICES AND DEPOSITS

TUITION RULES AND POLICIES

Please read carefully

- 1. All fees and tuition are payable IN ADVANCE.
- 2. All students must pay when absent from school.
- 3. Students are not charged for the two week Christmas vacation.
- 4. Day school students are charged for Thanksgiving, Spring Break and any other one-day or two-day holiday (including weather related closings).
- 5. If a student withdraws from school, the school must be notified IMMEDIATELY or we will continue to charge you on a weekly basis.
- 6. If a student must be absent for an extended length of time, other arrangements MUST be made with the office IN ADVANCE.
- 7. When an account falls behind, the student will be notified and will be given two additional weeks in which to pay the amount owed.
- 8. If the account is not paid in full at the end of two weeks, the student may be dropped from our rolls.
- 9. When this student wishes to re-enter, the enrollment fee must again be paid, as well as the balance due.
- 10. The fact that a person is dropped due to non-payment of fees is entered on his permanent record.
