At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County, on the 5th day of May, 1994, the following order was made and entered:

On a former day, to-wit, May 3, 1994, came the complainant, the Committee on Legal Ethics of The West Virginia State Bar, by Teresa A. Tarr, its attorney, and presented to the Court its recommendation for the reinstatement of the respondent's, Charles A. Anderson, license to practice law in the State of West Virginia, pursuant to Article VI, Part F, Section 19 of the Bylaws of The West Virginia State Bar, together with the Findings and Recommendations of the Committee on Legal Ethics upon the Petition for Reinstatement; the original record of the matter; the transcript of the hearing held on the 22nd day of January, 1994; the transcript of the deposition of John T. Landers; the Certificate of Expenses and Verification of R. Kemp Morton; and the various pleadings and exhibits filed with the Committee, and moved the Court to issue an order restoring the respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia contingent upon the respondent's reimbursement to the Committee on Legal Ethics of the costs incurred in the investigation of this matter in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$1,122.12).

Upon consideration whereof, it is ordered that the aforesaid documents referred to above be filed, and it is further ordered that the license to practice

law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Charles A. Anderson, be, and it hereby is, reinstated, contingent upon the respondent's reimbursement to the Committee on Legal Ethics of the costs incurred in the investigation of this matter in the amount of One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$1,122.12).
