ORDER

On August 15, 2023, the petitioner Kaylie S. Tucker filed a petition seeking to voluntarily resign as a member of the West Virginia State Bar in accordance with Rule 3.26(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure. On December 6, 2023, the Investigative Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair C. David Morrison, filed its written report in accordance with Rule 3.26(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petition be granted.

Upon consideration, the Court is of the opinion to and does grant the petition to voluntarily resign from the West Virginia State Bar.

It is ORDERED that the petitioner Kaylie S. Tucker has leave to voluntarily resign from the West Virginia State Bar. It is finally ordered that the petitioner shall comply with the client notification requirements of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, if applicable.
