## ORDER

On March 8, 2024, the Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Chief Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, in accordance with Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its petition praying for the Court to accept the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Keith L. Wheaton. The formal affidavit, under seal, of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment was filed on March 11, 2024.

Upon consideration and review on August 20, 2024, the Court does grant the petition.
