ORDER

On April 18, 2024, the Office of Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher Cipoletti, Chief Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, in accordance with Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its petition praying for the Court to accept the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, J. Mingo Winters. The formal affidavit, under seal, of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment was filed on April 22, 2024.

Upon consideration and review on October 17, 2024, the Court does grant the petition. It is ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent J. Mingo Winters is annulled by voluntary consent.

Justice Hutchison and Justice Wooton disqualified.
