## ORDER

On April 28, 2025, the petitioner Ann K. Rosen filed a petition seeking to voluntarily resign as a member of the West Virginia State Bar in accordance with Rule 3.26(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure. On June 2, 2025, the Investigative Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its Chair Letitia Neese Chafin, filed its written report in accordance with Rule 3.26(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petition be granted.
