

Learning Pathway: Post Beginner

Overview

This pathway builds on the skills from the beginner pathway and focuses on developing hands together playing. Many of the skills and shapes you have already encountered will now be strengthened, while you challenge yourself through more hands together work. The key focus is developing left hand playing through the study of one tune, *Lunaris*, explored with a range of different left hand ideas. You will also be encouraged to consider your own tastes and preferences in playing, culminating in your own arrangement and fostering creativity. To enrich your learning experience, you will have the option to choose additional tunes to learn alongside *Lunaris* from a list of suggestions. These suggested tunes include some of the skills taught in the chapters that follow.

1. 3rds and 5ths

Explore repertoire you are working on and look for the triad shape. Don't only focus on left hand, but find triad and inversion shapes in the right hand too.

7. Tucking Chords

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8. Turn Back Chords

9. Turn Back And Up Again Chords

POST BEGINNER Session 9:

- *Theory*: Triplets
- *Technique*: Turn Back and Up chord practice
- *Tune*: Learn Lunaris Version 9 and practice left hand pattern (turn back and up chords)

Practice playing triplets using a metronome.

OPTIONAL: Short Course: Master the Metronome (final 4 chapters - from Rhythm in Context to the end)

10. Counter Melody

POST BEGINNER Session 10:

- *Theory*: Counter Melody
- *Technique*: Counter Melody Practice
- *Tune*: Learn Lunaris Version 10 hands together

Create your own arrangement of Lunaris using elements from the 10 versions.

11. Personal Version

POST BEGINNER Session 11:

- Watch the concert of the various versions of Lunaris

Play your personal version of Lunaris and consider sharing it with others. You can record it, play it for your friends in a Harp Lounge Meet Up. You can also share it in the monthly Practise Performing Club.
