Meet Our Newest Board Member

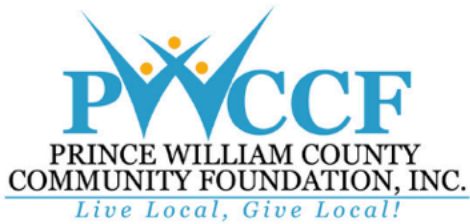

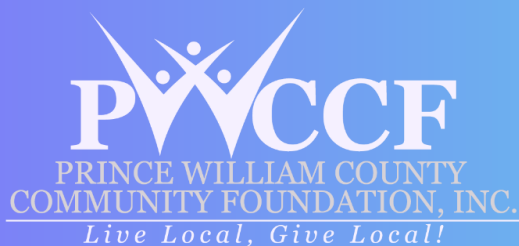
