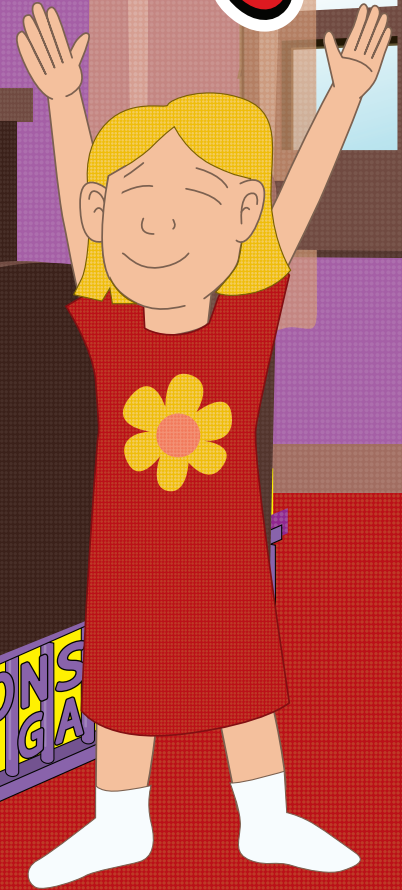

you can count on their tools, you can count on them too.

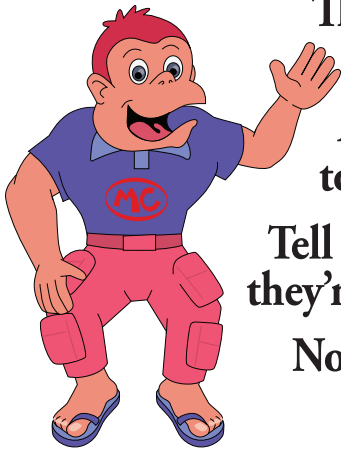
They'll do the job quickly – no need to worry –

to Club Monster Catchers, so join right along.

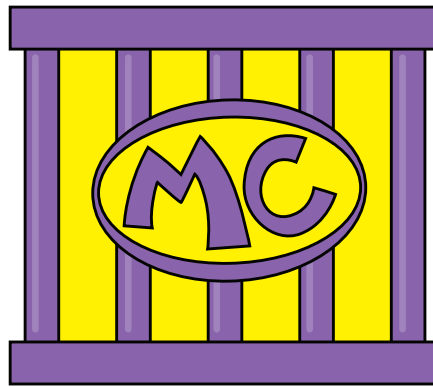
Tell all your friends who have monsters still lurking,

could they be blue?**




Afraid to look

did have hair.



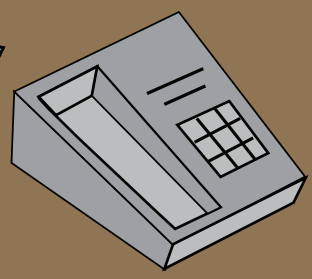
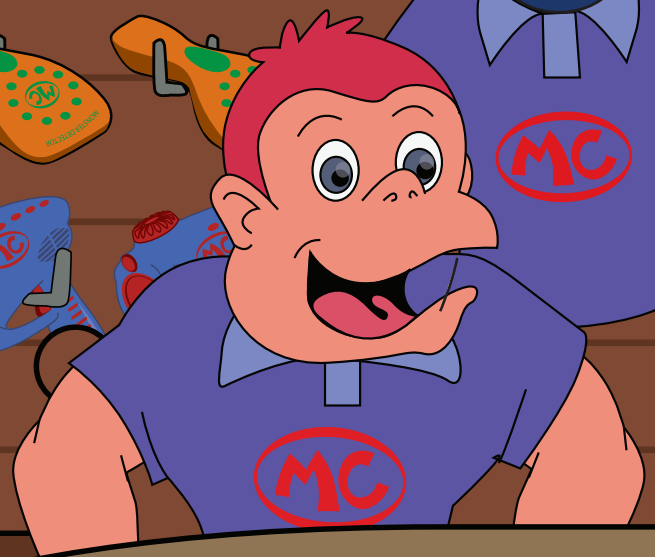
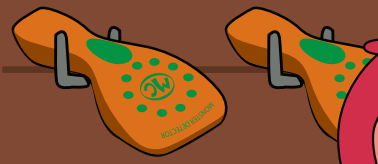
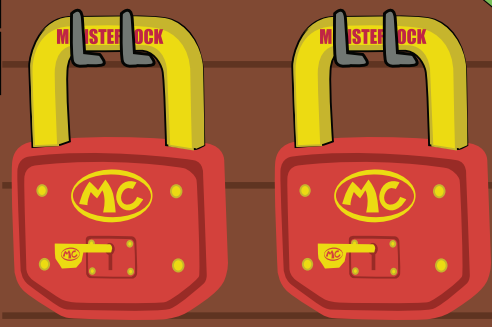
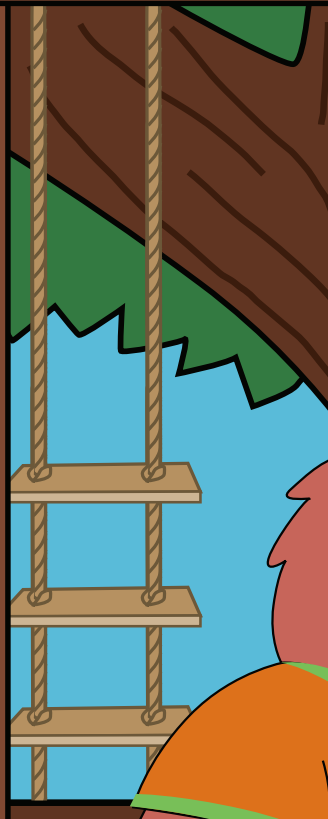


**Then one night

turned on the light.**

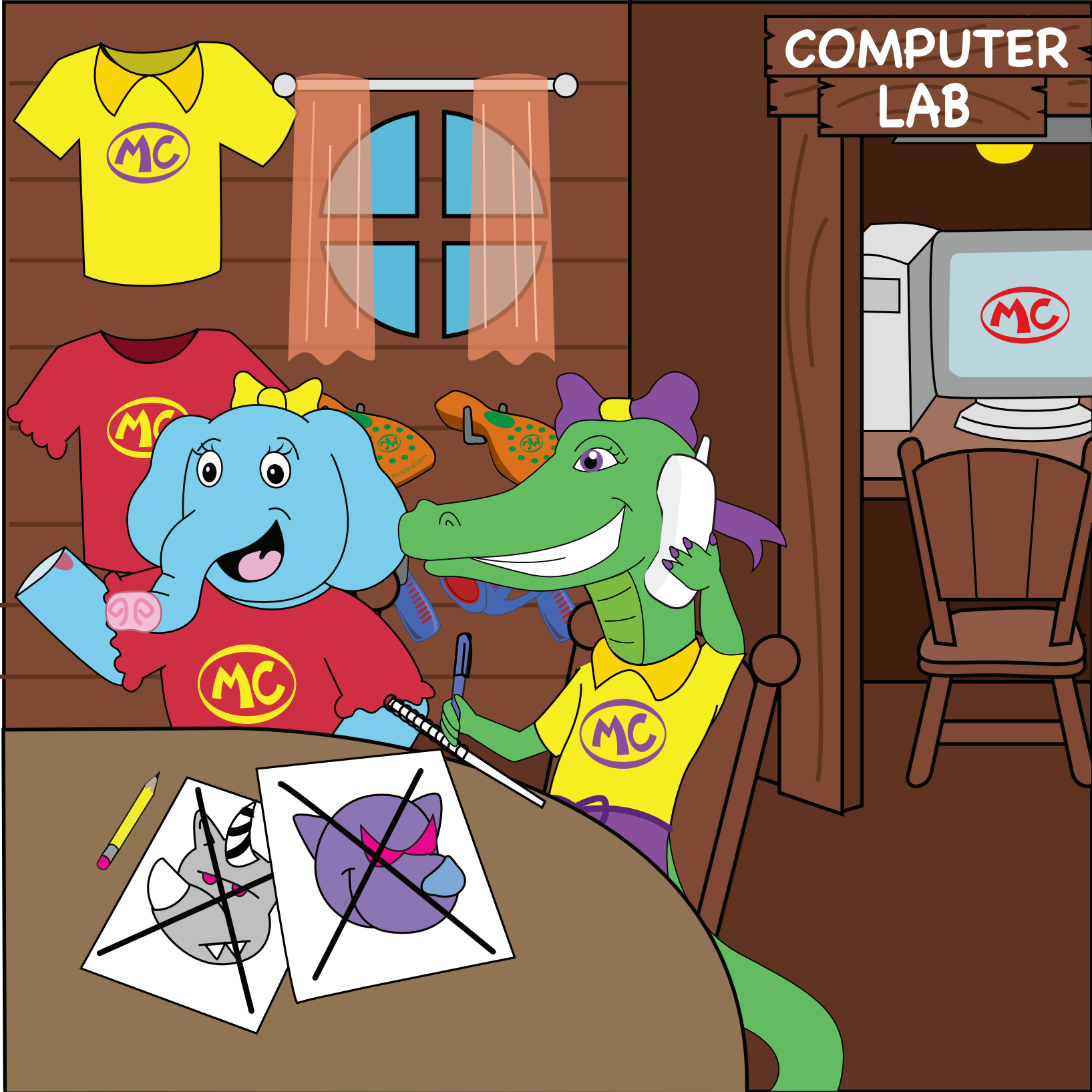
**So I decided



you'll know**

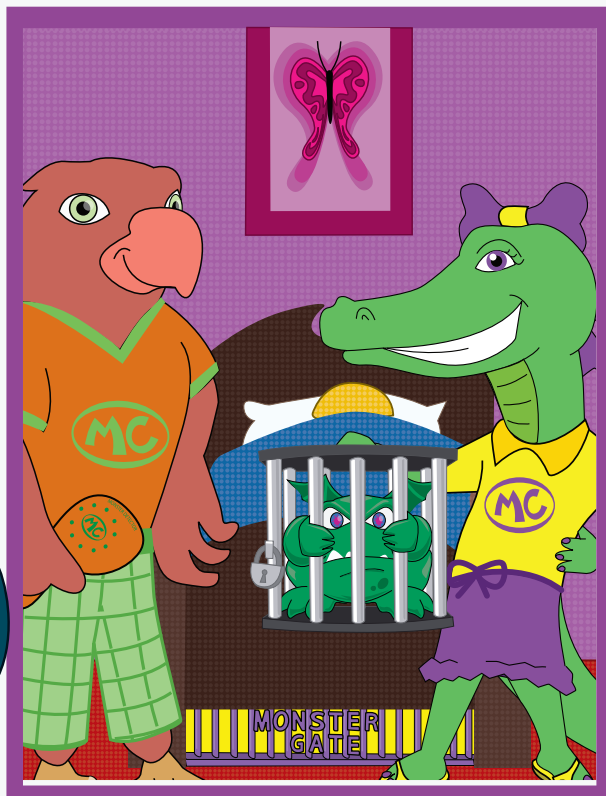
**The Monster Detector's

did its job in a hurry.**



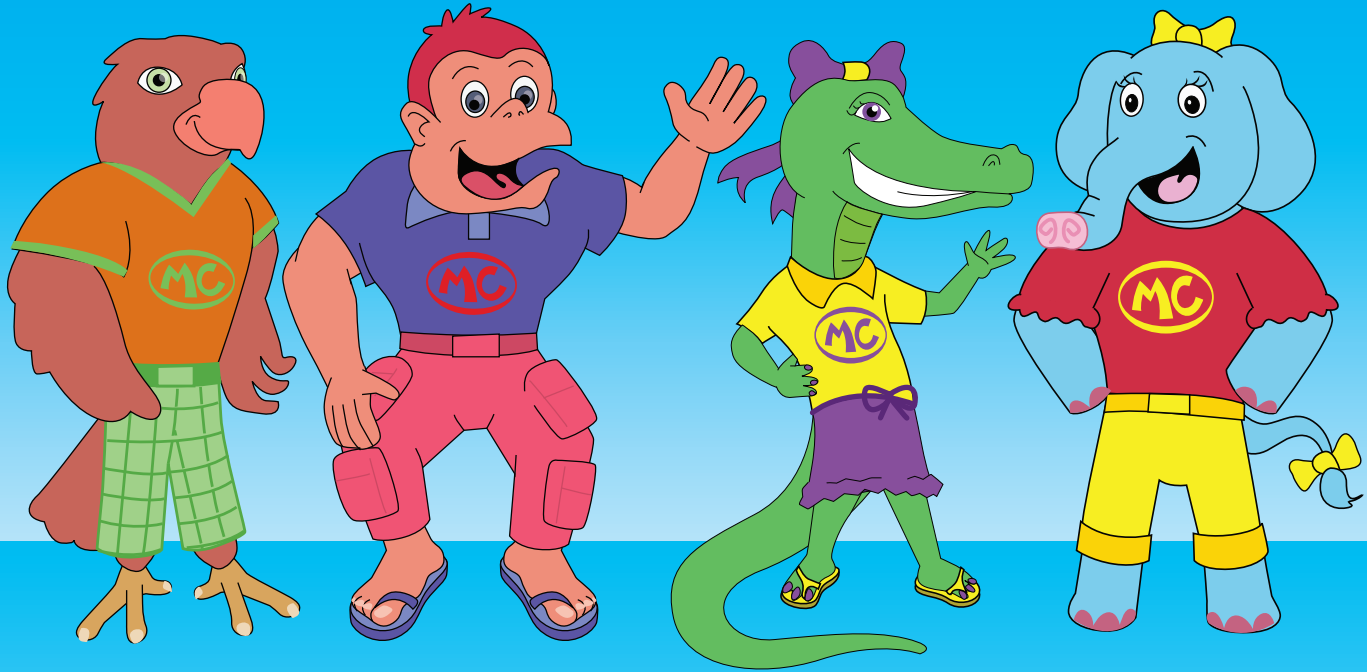


**The Monster Catchers
