# How To Play

## *The Set-up*

Tougher conversations can best be had off-site. Try a fondue restaurant! Just be sure to have a private room.

This game works best with smaller groups of 5-20.

Print the list of questions on pages 5-7, cut into strips, fold and put in a pot. If you have a fondue pot it makes it more fun, but really, a bag, hat, bowl or anything like that can work!

Next, have everyone write their name on a post-it sized piece of paper, fold it and drop into a 2nd pot or bowl. This is called the "NotSoFondDo" Pot.

Then, everyone draws 1 name from this Pot.... They can't draw their own name! Set aside the name for later.

Now it's time to try some Team Bourguignon....

## The Questions

1. What do you love most about your job?
2. What is the most frustrating part about your job?
3. What movie have you seen recently and what did you think about it?
4. Stand up and give us your best impression of a chicken pecking around the barnyard.
5. Share something you accomplished that you are extremely proud of.
6. If you could have any 3 people to dinner from anytime and anywhere in the world, who would you invite and why?
7. What are some ways you like to make your work fun?
8. Select 3 people in the room to genuinely compliment and do it now.
9. Which parts of your job do you struggle most with?
10. Stand up and go give the person across from you a nice heartfelt hug. If you can't figure out who is across from you give them each a nice heartfelt hug.

11. If you could change anything about the way you were raised, what would it be?
12. If you could wake up tomorrow having gained one quality or ability, what would it be?
13. What is one of the best books you've ever read and why do you recommend it?
14. What do you believe is your biggest contribution to your work?
15. Share something about your family that is important for us to know.
16. How do you feel about any of the recent company announcements?
17. Stand up and sing for us a few lines from one of your most favorite songs.
18. Share with us a memorable moment you shared with one of your kids or pets.
19. Share with us a time in your life that was extremely difficult.
20. Stand up and rap for us about why fondue is so awesome.
21. Share one of your proudest moments.

22. What TV show can you not miss?

23. Tell us about something you are secretly really good at that not many people know about.

24. What do you love to do for fun?

25. Recall a funny scene from a favorite movie and act it out/describe it/quote it.

26. Share something you've tried but are just terrible at.

27. Share a joke that you know.

28. What do you need more of in regard to your work?

29. What is one of your biggest goals?

30. Tell us about something you are deathly afraid of.

31. Share something that you wish you were better at in regard to your work.

32. Do your best celebrity impression.

Feel free to add some questions of your own tailored to the purpose of your meeting! Just don't forget to keep some FUN ones in there to keep the mood light, happy and energetic!





It's important to have a good facilitator to keep the game productive, light-hearted and still be able to cover some serious ground. Intertwining unrelated, fun questions allows people to loosen up and laugh, which lends to an open mind, and creates a more relaxed atmosphere where people feel more at ease in sharing what typically might be more difficult to discuss.

Let your team know this is a safe place to talk about what's on their mind and that you genuinely care about their input.
