MATCH GAME!

Players:

7-10 Players: 1 Host, 2-3 Contestants, 3-6 Celebrities

Object:

Score points by matching your answer to the Celebrities' answers!

Items Needed:

- Match Phrases (Included)
- Mini Dry-Erase Boards or Multiple Pieces of Paper and Markers for the Celebrities
- 1 Paper & Pen for each Contestant to keep score

How to Play:

Select a Host and separate the Contestants on one side and the Celebrities on the other. Give each Celebrity a dry-erase board or sheets of paper and a marker. One contestant plays at a time. The Host reads the phrase; each Celebrity has 10 seconds to write down their "fill-in-the-blank" answer. Once all pens are down, Contestant 1 states their answer. The Host then asks each Celebrity one at a time to reveal their answer. A point is earned for each matched Celebrity answer to the Contestant's answer. Keep track of matched points by simply logging hash marks on each Contestant's score sheet. Play then moves to Contestant 2 and so on through each round. Celebrities are encouraged to actually take on a celebrity role and get into character to make it more fun!

Rules:

Celebrities should keep their answers to themselves until the Host asks them to share. The Host has final say as to whether a questionable answer matches or not.

How to Win:

Earn the most points! Decide ahead of time how many rounds you will play. The Contestant with the most hashmarks at the end of the game wins! You can then rotate play so everyone has a chance to be a Contestant and a Celebrity!

WIN, LOSE OR DRAW!

Players:

Minimum 2 people can play this game; 2 Teams & a Host ideal

Object:

Score points by getting your team to guess well-known phrases by drawing them out!

Items Needed:

- Paper – big flipchart paper works best!
- Markers
- 1 minute Timer

**There is a no-host option if you prefer; you will need internet access! See below

How to Play:

Divide into 2 teams. Team A goes first while Team B observes.

One player from Team A is chosen to draw first. The Host reveals a puzzle from the list to the player and starts the timer. The player draws out the phrase as his teammates attempt to guess what it is. If the puzzle is not guessed correctly before the time is up, Team B takes over and gets the chance to try at the same puzzle. Play goes back and forth until a team gets it right or there is nobody left to guess. Either the host or the other team keeps track of time.

**No host needed! If you would rather have everyone able to play, you may access the puzzles online so players only see one puzzle at a time. In this case, DO NOT print the included list of puzzles and try not to look at them haha! Access here: <https://meganbendtzen.com/wldhost/>

Rules:

No speaking, singing or gestures allowed! Also no writing letters, numbers or blank lines to indicate how many words are in the phrase. When a word is guessed, that word may be written.

TIP: If you are trying to convey “sounds like” we like to draw a simple ear in a square. *(a quicky-drawn ear kinda looks like the number "3" - a little crude, but it works for this purpose!)*

Once a player draws they may not guess during that round, since they already know the answer! (Duh!) Should seem obvious but you never know. haha!

If there is doubt or question as to whether a puzzle has been guessed correctly, the host can make the final call or teams must agree if it's close enough (ie – the puzzle might be “Making hay” but the team guesses “Make hay” – we say close enough.)

How to Win:

Earn the most points!

Decide ahead of time how many points you will play to (5, 10, etc.)

Each correctly guessed puzzle earns a point for that team.

WIN, LOSE OR DRAW HOST SCRIPT

The Following Pages are for the HOST ONLY!

Welcome to WIN.... LOSE..... or DRAW!!!

I'm your host, (*your name*) and we are going to have a lot of fun tonight. This is the show where contestants try to draw phrases and get their teams to guess what it is... and these people are NOT artistically inclined, haha and that's what makes it so fun.

Let's meet our teams... (*introduce Team A*)

Welcome Team A (*if they have a team name it's more fun!*)

And now let's meet your challengers... Team B!

(*introduce Team B*)

(*Decide which team goes first by picking a number, rolling dice or playing Rock, Paper, Scissors.*)

All right, Team (x) won the challenge, who's going to draw first?

Invite up the first player, show them the puzzle and set the timer for 1 minute! Be sure to use another piece of paper to cover the rest of the puzzles! Remind players of the rules - No writing letters, numbers or blank lines; the symbol for "sounds like;" writing the words as they are guessed. As the host, you make the call on questionable plays!

FAMILY FEUD!

Players:

Minimum 5 people can play this game; 2 Teams w/Team Names & a Host is ideal

Object:

Score points by getting your team to guess the survey results from random questions!

Items Needed:

- Survey Questions and Answers (included)
- Buzzer - place a small toy between the 2 contestants and whoever grabs it first gets to answer
If you prefer you can also download a "buzzer app" on 2 devices. We prefer old-school! haha
- Strike Sheets (included - to keep track of strikes!)
- Paper/Pen/Calculator to keep score (depending how mathematically inclined you are)

How to Play:

Select a Host and divide into 2 teams, sitting in a chosen order for each team. For each round, 1 player from each team will come up to the "podium" where the host will read the survey question. The first player to "buzz in" will give their answer. If their answer is anywhere on the list, they get to decide if they'd like to play or pass. If their answer is not on the list, the other player gets to guess. If they still don't get one right, it goes back and forth between teams, with only 1 player giving an answer at a time. Once a correct answer is revealed, that team will decide to play or pass. The host will then go down the line for the "playing" team, with each player getting 3 seconds to give a guess. (kissing optional - for those that remember the Richard Dawson days haha!) If they guess correctly, play continues for that team. The host should put a checkmark next to each correct answer once it's given. If they guess incorrectly, they are given a strike. Use the included Strike Sheets to keep track. Once a team gets 3 strikes, the other team gets 1 chance to give a guess. If their answer is on the list, they win that round, if not, points go to the other team. For the next round, start with the next players in line so everyone gets a chance at the "podium!"

Rules:

No whispering or giving answers to teammates - everyone is on their own to come up with an answer... EXCEPT when your team is not "playing" you may collaborate to come up with your one guess should the other team get 3 strikes. The Host has final say on any questionable answers.

How to Win:

Earn the most points! Decide ahead of time how many rounds you will play. When a team wins a round, they earn 1 point for each correct answer that was guessed. Simply add up the checkmarks!

The Following Pages are for the HOST ONLY!

"It's time... for the Family Feud!!

Introducing the (x) Family Playing against the (x) Family!

And I'm your host, *(your name)*! Now let's play the Family Feud!!

Let's meet our families... (welcome each member of the family... people can keep their own names or take on personas and really act out the part! *"I'm the bratty teenager!" "I'm the bossy wife!" "I'm the drunk uncle!" (haha, ok don't get offended so fast, this is meant to be fun and funny so just play with it and don't take yourself too seriously)*

OK it's time for Round 1...

(call up the first players on each team)

Let's Play!

(Go to Survey Questions and continue to call up players as it's their turn. Refer to Instructions and don't forget to ask if they're going to Pass or Play!

To emulate the game's dramatic effect, when a player gives an answer, you can comment on their guess and say "OK let's see if it's up there... survey says?" and shout out their answer.

If it's there say ding ding ding and put a checkmark next to their answer. If it's not there, make a buzzing sound and slam down the Strike!)

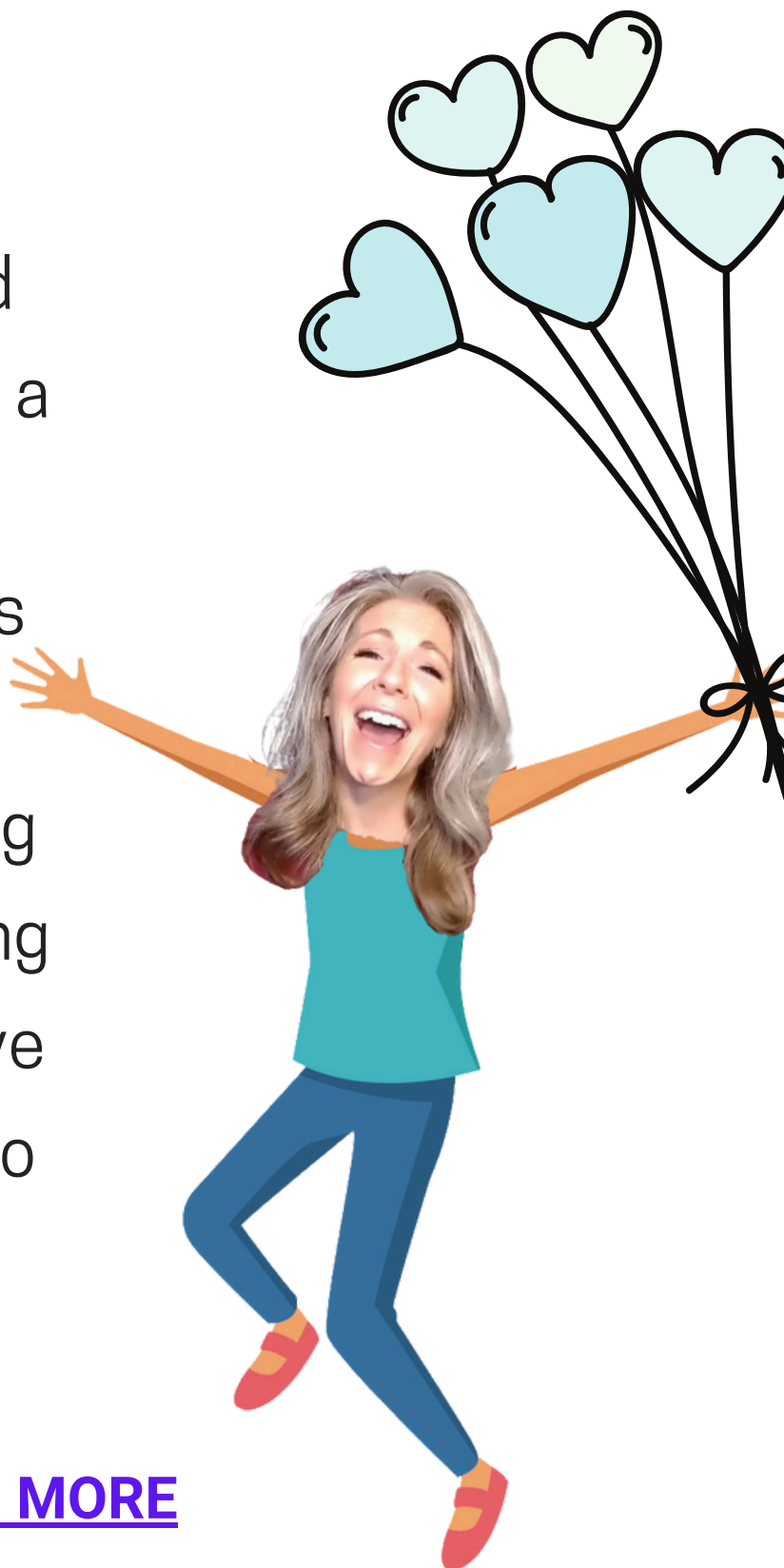

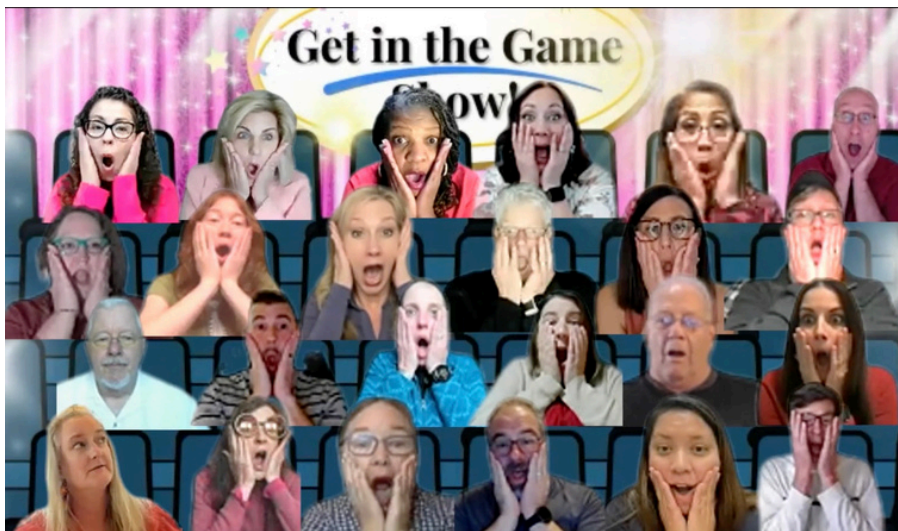
