● SCIENCE CONCEPT

Understanding the water cycle—evaporation, condensation, and precipitation—and how God designed water to sustain all living things as part of His covenant with creation.

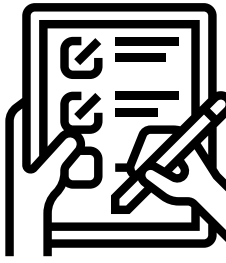
● DISCUSSION PROMPT

What You'll Do: Create your own mini water cycle to see how clouds and rain form.

What You Need: Clear glass jar, Hot water (adult help), Ice cubes, Small plate, Blue food coloring (optional)

Why It Matters: Farmers depend on God's water cycle for life, growth, and harvest. Each rainfall is a reminder of His faithfulness and His promise—symbolized by the rainbow

Pour hot water into the jar (about  full)

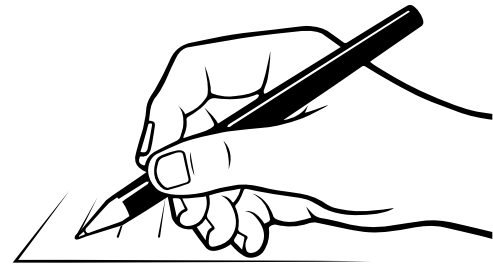
● STEP TWO
