


4 Quick Ways to Integrate Vocabulary into the Classroom

TALLY, HO!

Write your Tier 2 vocabulary words on the board. When a student uses the word in context throughout the day, add a tally mark. At the end of the week, discuss why some words were easier to use than others. Learn more here <https://vocabularyluau.com/how-tally-marks-can-help-you-teach-vocabulary/>

VOCABULARY CHARADES

Have students act out their Tier 2 vocabulary words and have other students guess. Take it to the next level by having students record their acting on FlipGrid (<https://info.flipgrid.com/>) at centers, and when others visit the center, they comment and guess the word..




FRAYER IT UP!

For your Tier 3 words, have students create a Frayer model of the word. This can easily be done at a center and even online at <https://www.kapwing.com/>



GET TO THE ROOT OF IT

Tier 3 words often have Greek or Latin roots and affixes. Tie their understanding to deeper meaning by teaching Greek and Latin roots and how affixes change the meaning of the word. Try <https://quizlet.com/> to have students make digital study cards..


