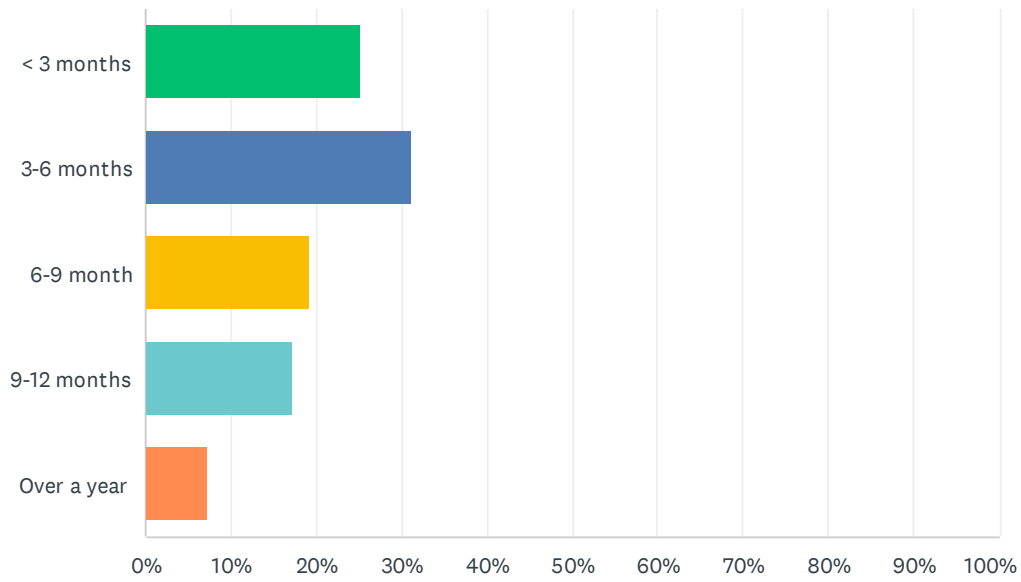


## Q1 How long have you been a member with SOS?

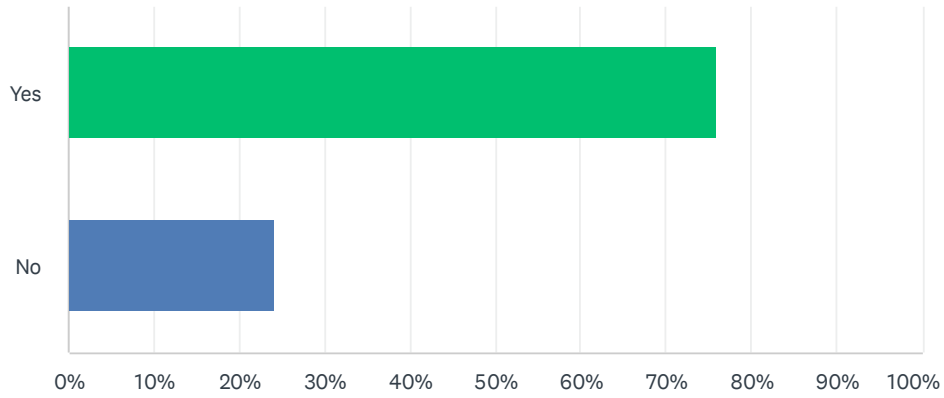

## Q2 Were you familiar with or have you traded options BEFORE becoming a member?

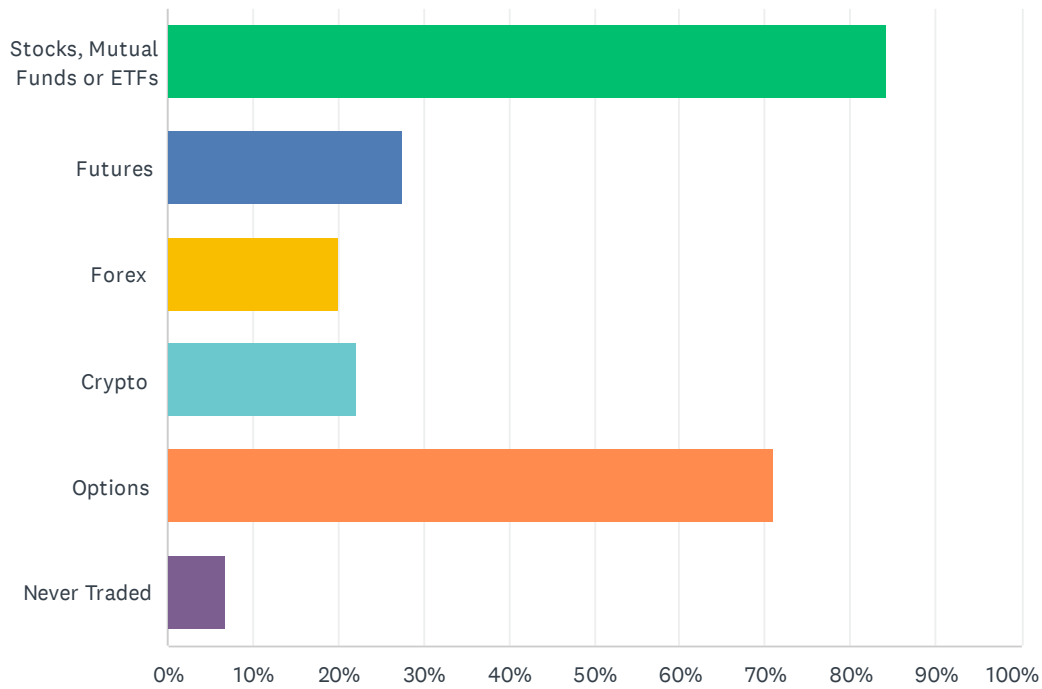

### Q3 What have you traded in the past? (Choose all the apply)

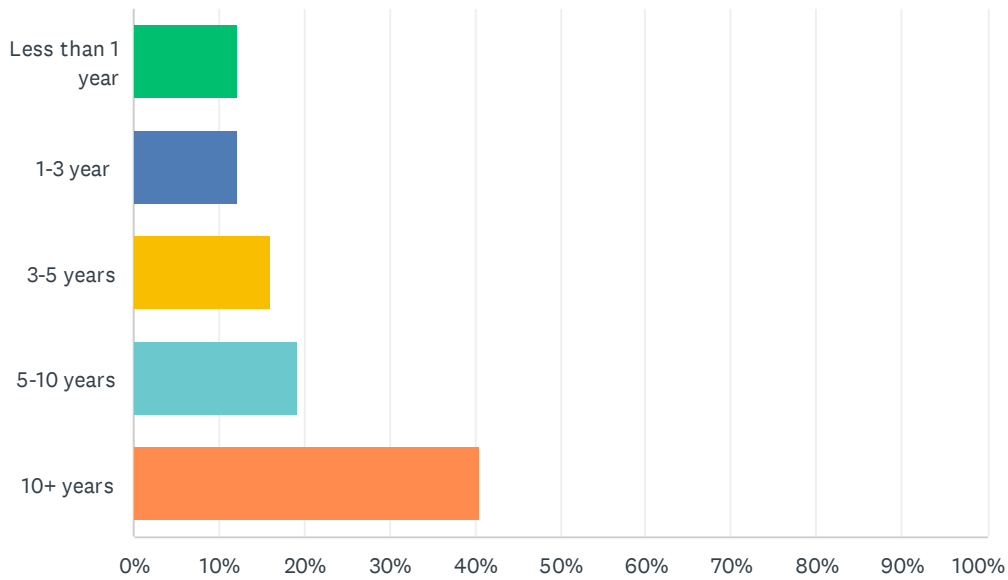

## Q4 How long have you traded BEFORE joining SOS?

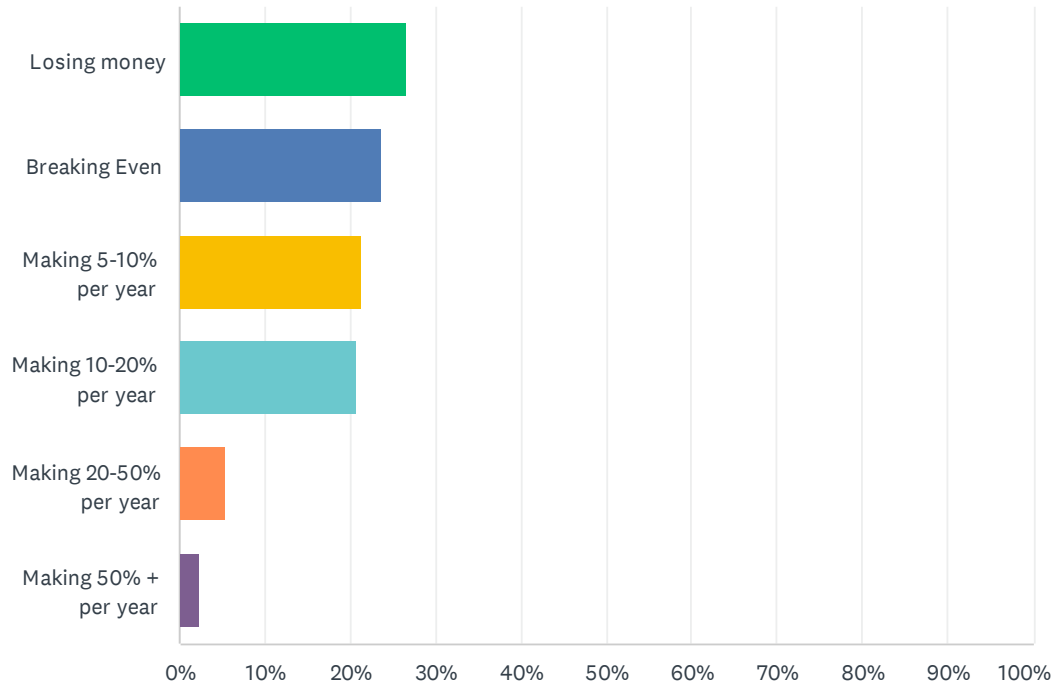

### Q5 What results were you typically getting prior to joining SOS? (Average over all)

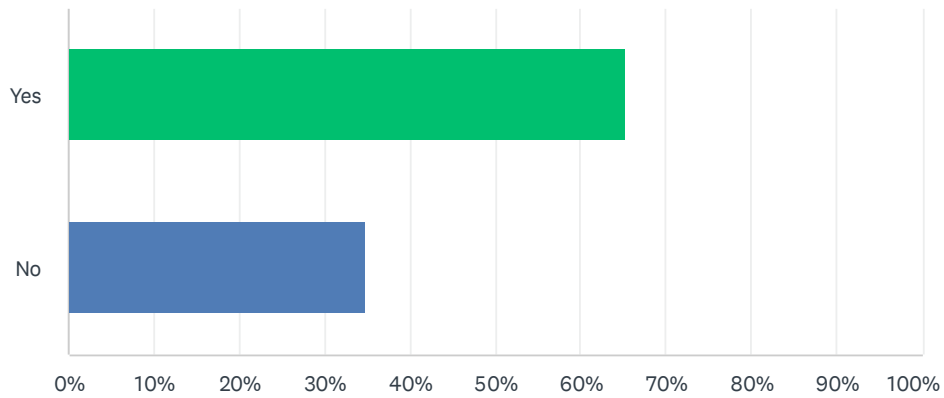

### Q6 Have you started trading LIVE yet with Tom's strategy?

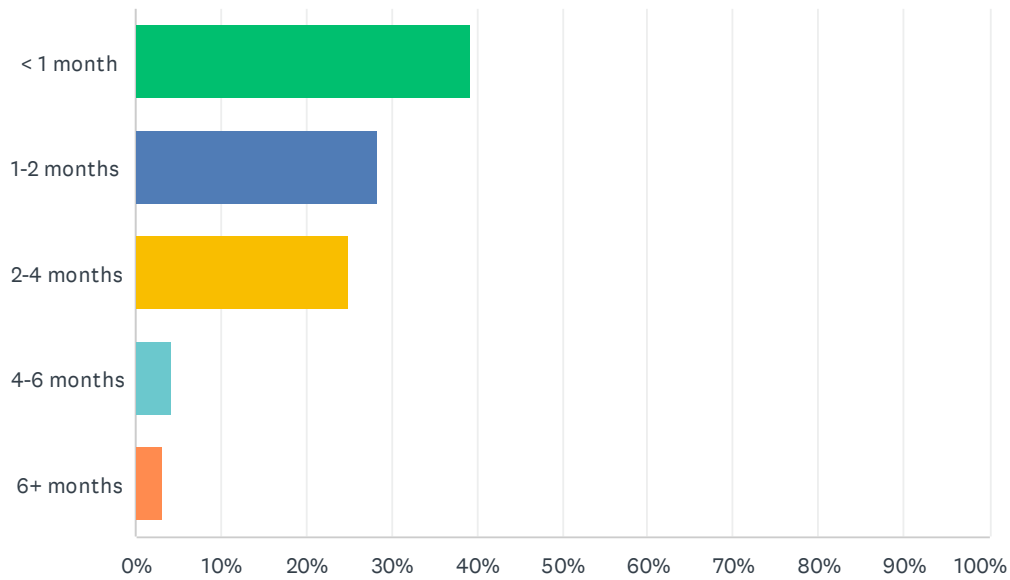

## Q7 How many months did you paper trade with SOS before going live?

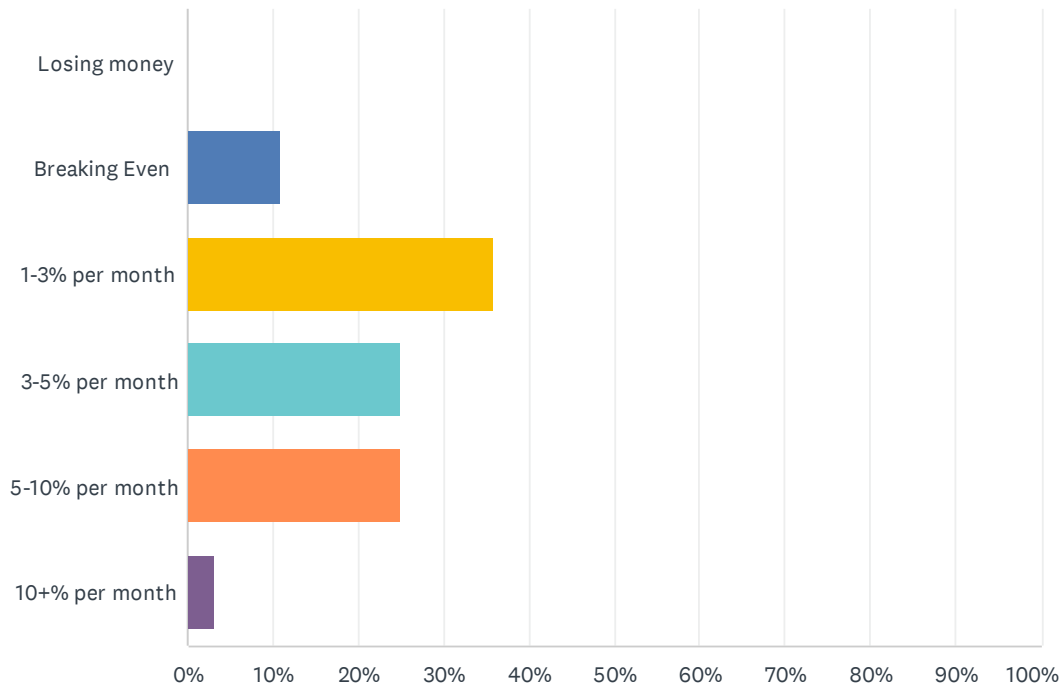

## Q8 What are your average monthly returns using Tom's strategy?

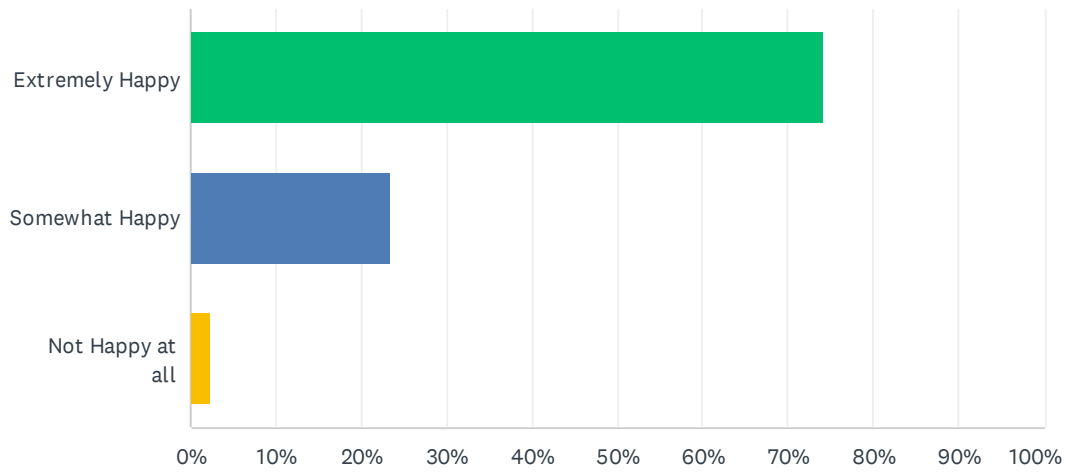

## Q9 Are you happy with Tom and Short Option Success?

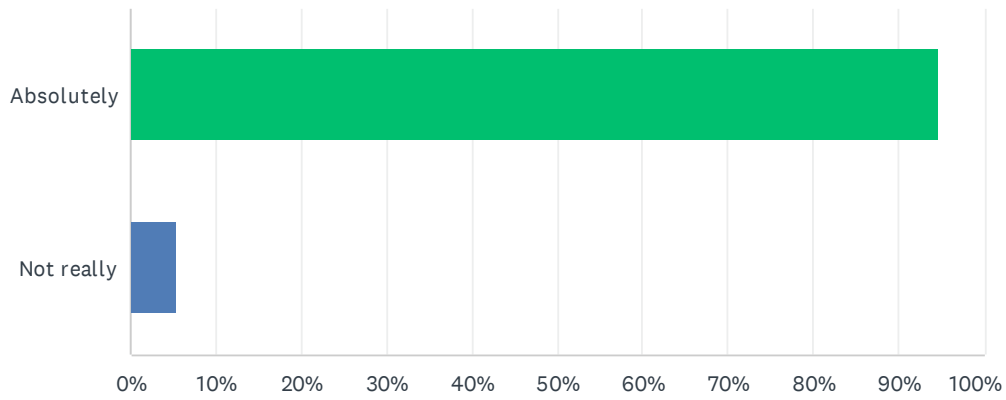

# Q10 Would you recommend Short Option Success to others?

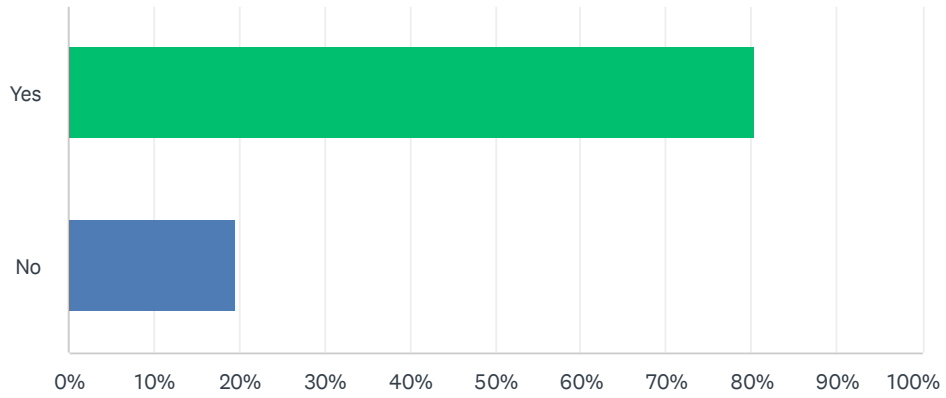

10	1. I would think that this would be quite a difficult learning curve for someone who has never traded before or only traded stocks. 2. The introductory videos on the SOS website are extremely helpful and important, but can be improved. The first impression I had when joining from the ads and salesman were that the options would simply be held until expiration. It was quite an adjustment to finally learn that Tom and others are taking profits much earlier. So I think this could be better clarified in new videos along with an overview of the numerous strategies that could be employed. Simply list them with a clear separate section for each strategy with the pluses and minuses. 3. I really like my coach, Keith, but I have come to realize that the coaches probably teach very different things and strategies. Again, I think SOS could have all coaches outline a consistent set of lessons and strategies approved by SOS, and in addition teach and discuss their own preferences, making it clear that this is what they do and that there are many ways to personalize one's strategies. 4. I would think many newbies would need a better introduction to the futures markets that underlie the options trading. Futures are very different from stocks, and options are very different from both stocks and futures. 5. Tom's emphasis on cutting losses was the most important lesson. It can be made even better by some clear examples of what financially can happen if the trader does not exit a trade, and if the option goes into the money and the extreme consequences of what happens if the option is exercised to the seller (us). importance of this discipline on the newbie. He/she cannot let it happen. 6. The emphasis on the psychology of the trader is so very important. Good job focusing so much on this. 7. I had a hard time getting used to Slack and where to see Tom's trades. A better job of hand holding the newbie is needed and also clarifying how to attend weekly meetings on zoom (not on Slack), and to watch recorded meetings. etc. Maybe more written / printable instructions on these educational tools would be very helpful including web addresses and login in procedures and how to navigate the website (real basic stuff). Your printable document on the many "Futures Grouping - Contract Data" was an extremely helpful tool that I refer to often in my notebook as I begin to trade. I would think more printable documents summarizing important teaching points would reduce the number of questions that coaches will be asked. 8. I took very extensive notes while going through all the SOS lessons. It helped me learn and I have them in my notebook to review often. Encourage doing this I would suggest. 9. The lessons tell us to keep a "Journal" but there is no journal template to use!! My coach shared his, but I imagine every client is doing something different and reinventing from scratch. This is a big problem. I would suggest reviewing many of the best traders' journals and creating a beautiful downloadable blank journal for the new student to use right away, so he/she can start this discipline. I created my own on a spreadsheet and it took hours and is still being tweaked. I have added columns for recording the profit/loss for each commodity I trade, so that over time I will see which commodities I am most profitable with. 10. Your question above that I was forced to answer about whether or not I am making a profit with SOS was not applicable for me. I have not traded long enough. A third option for answering that question would have been "Too soon to know".
