UNDERSTANDING YOUR LOAN


Key questions to clarify your current situation.

- What's my current loan balance and interest rate?
- Am I current, delinquent, or in default?
- Do I have an escrow account? If not, am I responsible for taxes/insurance separately?
- Who owns my loan is it Fannie Mae, Freddie Mac, or a private investor?










Ask smart questions about your actual options.


- Am I eligible for a loan mod or payment redux?
- Is forbearance still an option, and if so, what are the repayment terms?
- Are there any FHA, VA, or other government-backed programs I qualify for?
- What workout option would you recommend for someone in my situation?



UNDERSTANDING THE PROCESS

Make sure you know what's ahead.





- Will collection activity continue while my application is being reviewed?
- Who can I contact to check the status of my application?







MANAGING MONTHLY PAYMENTS


Ask how to keep things affordable and safe.

- What's the lowest monthly payment I could reasonably expect?
- Will this include escrow for taxes and insurance?
- Can I make trial payments while I wait for final approval?
- Are there any risks to accepting the option you're offering? **See this step in**



AVOIDING DELAYS / PITFALLS

Get clarity to keep things moving smoothly.
