Merit Bars may be awarded to DeMolays to recognize their achievements in various phases of Chapter activity with additional bars available for outside activities.

There are 22 categories of Merit Bars that members can earn, with each category having five colors designating the number of times a DeMolay has received an award in that category.

The color designation for the number of times a merit bar is earned is as follows:



This month we will look at the following Merit Bars: **Fundraising, Merit, Religion** and **Visitation**.



The **Fundraising Merit Bar** is awarded to a DeMolay for working on at least three different fund-raising projects for the Chapter, for a total of twenty hours, without direct financial remuneration to himself.



The **Merit Merit Bar** is awarded for contributing twenty hours of service to DeMolay in an area not covered by another bar, with no financial remuneration to either individual or the Chapter.



The **Religion Merit Bar** is awarded for attending at least thirty regular weekly religious services per year.



The **Visitation Merit Bar** is awarded for six visitations at regular Chapter meetings of a Chapter or Manor other than his own, or a total traveled distance of 150 miles (one way).

Chaplain: 1 member




