DIY JAW SOOTHING ROLLER BLEND

Ingredients:

- ·1 tbsp fractionated coconut oil (or another carrier oil)
- ·1 drop Roman chamomile essential oil
- ·1 drop lavender essential oil

Instructions:

- 1. Add ingredients to a 10ml roller bottle.
- 2. Shake gently before each use.
- 3. Roll along the jawline and behind ears not inside the mouth.
- 4. Use 1-2x daily or as needed. Always patch test first.

Tip: You can also infuse olive oil with dried chamomile and lavender instead of using essential oils for an ultra-gentle blend.
