# Student Service Learning (SSL)

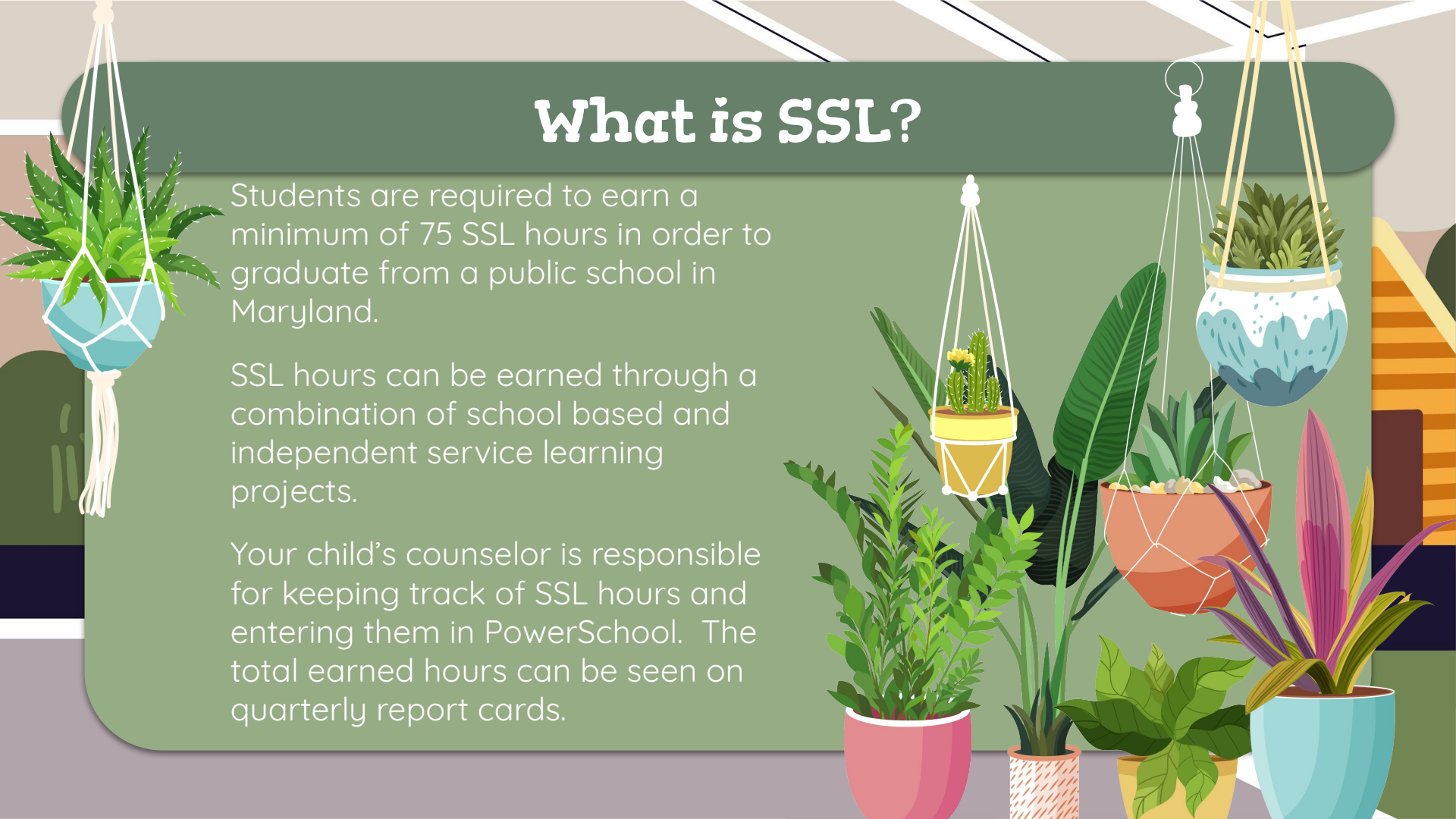
75 hours to graduate

# What is SSL?

Students are required to earn a minimum of 75 SSL hours in order to graduate from a public school in Maryland.

SSL hours can be earned through a combination of school based and independent service learning projects.

Your child's counselor is responsible for keeping track of SSL hours and entering them in PowerSchool. The total earned hours can be seen on quarterly report cards.



# School Based Projects

- 3rd grade - 5 hours
- 4th grade - 5 hours
- 5th grade - 5 hours
- 6th grade - 10 hours - Formally NorthBay, now school based environmental lessons
- 7th grade - 10 hours - Walk-a-thon supporting Wells for Ghana
- 8th grade - 10 hours - anti bullying campaign tied to Anne Frank
- 10th Grade - 10 hours
- Total - 55 hours for school based projects

- This leaves 20 hours that will have to be earned through independent projects.
- Independent projects must be PRE-APPROVED by the SSL coordinator (your child's counselor)
- A list of potential not for profit agencies where hours might be earned can be found on the independent SSL approval form.

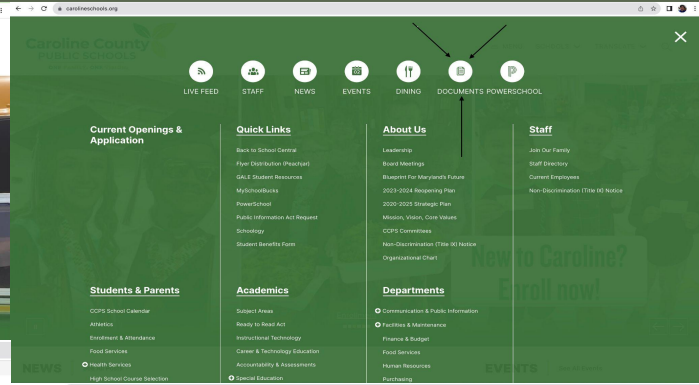
