

# **AV REQUIREMENTS**

# FOR MICHAEL ALLISON

## **Presentation & Equipment:**

- Michael uses PowerPoint slides for his presentation. His presentation will be provided in either **PowerPoint** or **Keynote** format (16:9 aspect ratio). The preferred format will be shared in advance.
- He will bring a backup laptop (MacBook). Please ensure an HDMI adapter is available for connection.
- Michael also brings a thumb drive with his presentation loaded and ready to transfer to the house computer if needed.
- The presentation contains embedded videos, so **audio support** is required.

## **Microphone:**

 Michael prefers a wireless lavalier lapel mic or a Madonna-style headset mic to allow for hands-free movement during his presentation.

#### Audio-Visual Check:

 An AV check is required at least 1-Day Prior or 1-Hour prior to his presentation, with the check lasting between 10-20 minutes. However, Michael's team will work with you to schedule the exact time that works best for you.

# **Stage Notes:**

- Michael prefers to move around for maximum audience engagement.
- Please remove any lectern/podium prior to Michael coming on stage as this blocks the view from audience members and minimizes audience engagement.
- Michael's preference is to have rounds for room set up, however, he can work with any room style (theater; rounds, or classroom).
- To have the highest-energy presentation, a single screen should be off to one side or well above the stage, not center stage because the presenter is the focal point and the slides are merely supplemental.
- For Question & Answer sessions, please provide hand held microphones for the attendees to ask questions.

### Other Needs:

- A projector and screen will be needed for the presentation.
- A confidence monitor and countdown clock are strongly preferred.
- Michael may use custom fonts, so please ensure Cremona and Auttera fonts are downloaded in advance if requested.

This setup ensures that Michael can deliver a smooth and engaging keynote presentation tailored to the event's specific needs.
