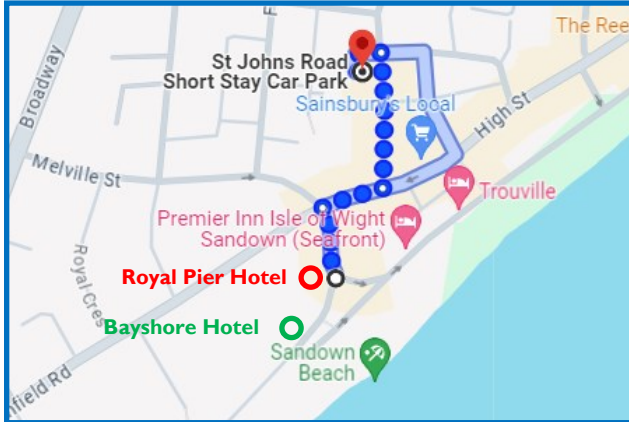

PARKING

There is No Parking at the hotels but there is on road parking along the seafront, as well as 2 public Car Parks close by (St Johns Road Short Stay and York Street Long Stay).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

If you are travelling by train, the hotel is 0.5 miles from Sandown (SDN) Station - about a 10 minute walk - marked on the map above. The closest Bus Stop is Melville Street if travelling from Newport or Ventnor (less than 300 yard from the hotel) or Beachfield Road from Ryde (about 200 yards).
