



20th September 2025 – Newbury County Show

H.A.P.E.E Summer Finale !!



Competition:

All phases for all levels will be held on grass. We have 1 large (135m x 88m) grass arena at the Newbury County show on Sat 20th so there will be plenty of room for dressage, EOH and warm up areas. Times will be given out on 14th September but we expect the timetable to be as follows:

- Intro and Novice classes will run in the morning, with the intro starting at 9am and Novice at 9.45am with Prize givings expected between 1-2pm
- Inter B will start around 12.30pm and PYO will follow on from that. Prize givings for those classes are expected to be around 5.30pm.

Prize givings will be mounted for the top 6 for all classes on the day and for the top 6 final league placings which will be posted on the day of the show.

Stabling:

Stabling is available locally (10-15 min drive) for Friday 19th September to help those who are coming from a distance away. There is no stabling on the showground. The yard is known to the organisers and recommended. Your horse will need up to date vaccinations and a valid passport. They will provide bedding for you.

Please PM Sarah Vousden of A Cob and a Connie for contact details for the stabling. You will then be able to book directly with the owner of the stables and can agree arrival times at that point.

Please note: there is no hook up or accommodation available at the stables but you are welcome to stay on site in your own transport.

Prizes:

- Rosettes and Prizes to 6th place in each class
- £75 Champion equipment voucher for highest EOH % on the day
- Champion and Reserve Champion for the Summer league to be awarded at this event:
 - Winners will receive rugs, sashes, a full size Bull and Rosettes
 - Reserve Champions will receive Sash and Rosettes

Entries:

Enter in the usual way using My Riding Life link for A Cob and a Connie / H.A.P.E.E. events. Entries will close on Sunday 14th September at Midday.

As part of the entry fee, you will receive 2 complimentary passes **per horse** to the Newbury County show as well as 1 vehicle pass for your horsebox / car and trailer.

* If you wish to buy further vehicle passes, please do so by adding to your basket at point of entry. These are £10 per extra vehicle.

* If you wish to purchase more entry passes for spectators, please add these to your basket when you complete your entry. If you buy through the normal Newbury County show website, your guests with you will not be able to access the equine car park area. If you purchase at point of entry via MRL, they will be able to as wristbands will be sent accordingly. Extra spectator passes are £18 for adults and £5 for under 16's when purchased through MRL, £20 online through Newbury County show and will be £25 on the gate.

Parking passes and any extra tickets purchased, will all be emailed to you individually the week before the show.

Parking passes will need to be visible at the **green entrance gate which is the equine parking area** and exhibitor wristbands can be exchange at the equine office, any person wishing to access the showground further than the parking area will require a wristband.

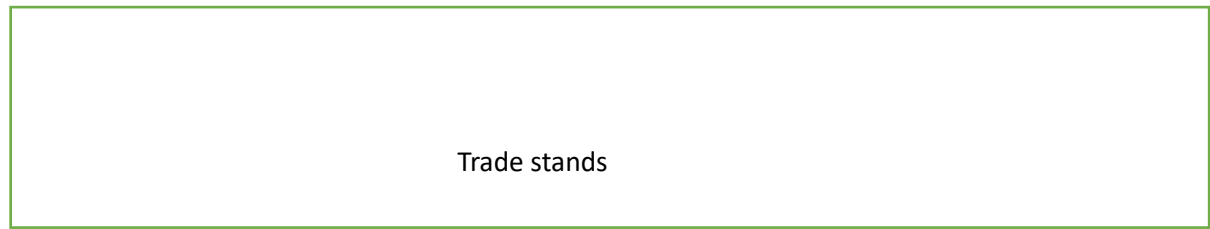
Logistics:

The show is open daily from 8.30am – 6pm and the equine car park closes at 8pm

Although this is a County show, where there will be Heavy horses, shetlands and scurry horses present and in the equine car park, we will not share any of the horse walk ways with these horses. We will be in the arena marked in Orange on the Map and have a walk way from the car park that we will be sharing only with the Pony Club who are in the ring next door to us.
