Your students will choose a country to research and learn about over the next several weeks. Please have them use the internet and books from home or the library to gather information.

All work will be done at home then presented to their peers at co-op.

We cannot stress enough the importance of encouraging public speaking, research, and creative skills. Presentations will be held on November 21st after regular scheduled classes between 3-3:30pm.

Presentation length should be as follows:

3rd-5th grade 1-2 minute long

6th-8th grade 3 minutes long

POSTER:

There is no set template for this report beyond the basic trifold poster background. Below you will see suggested information per grade level. We would love for students to include how God is working in their country. They can do this by researching a famous Christian, missionary/servant of Christ, or a Christian ministry/organization that is doing God's work.

Other information may include the largest tourist attraction, notable holidays, cultural music, traditional dress, current events, and so much more!
