

HOMELESSNESS & PANHANDLING


San Antonio has a population of about 2.2 million people. There are an estimated 3,000 who are homeless. Bexar County has spent \$75 million to assist the homeless.

Additionally, there are many agencies such as Haven for Hope and SAMM Shelter as well as emergency shelters that help those in need. The goal is to give them a hand up, not continual hand outs. If you encounter someone who is incoherent or someone approaches your car window and wants money, please call **SAPD non-emergency at 210-207-7273**. Our SAPD SAFFE Officer, Claudia Ramirez, strongly recommends not giving out money. Permits from the City are required to do any soliciting on public property.


HELP PREVENT OAK WILT

In order to prevent the devastating effects of Oak Wilt Fungus, oak trees, <u>SHOULD NOT be pruned or cut down between</u>
<u>FEBRUARY 1 - JUNE 30</u>. During approved pruning dates, please be sure to hire a licensed tree pruner and make sure they spray the wounds *immediately* using latex or commercial tree wound paint.
