- 1 DOUBTS.** Satan began his seduction and infection of Eve and Adam (Genesis 3 says he was “with her”) with small, seemingly benign questions, then suggestions that God was not being totally generous or truthful with them. This is how he plants the virus.
- 2 DISTRUST.** If we are not “taking those thoughts captive in obedience to Christ” (2 Cor. 10:5), then a spirit of distrust becomes a stronghold that causes us to negatively perceive **anything** said or done by the people or entities we are doubting and distrust. And in reality, we don’t respond to truth. We respond to our *perceptions* of the truth.
- 3 DISTANCING.** Stage three is when the enemy lures us to distance ourselves from those people or entities by rejecting opportunities for collaboration and cooperation with open hearts to clarify our perceptions (Matthew 18), and instead, pursue our own agendas which we tend to view as far more noble, pure, and godly.
- 4 DISTORTION.** The longer he keeps us distanced and isolated with a few people who have bought into our one-sided negative perspectives against those people and entities, the more disoriented and distorted our narratives become regarding the truth.
- 5 DIVISION.** His final goal and proof of the virus is discord and division in the Body of Christ, rather than love, grace, and unity, even with our diversity. Rather than working through the differences so that we may be known by our love and commitment to each other in Christ, He lures us to point fingers, make accusations, and break away.

Love

LOVING GOD IS OUR TOP PRIORITY. The greatest commandment: And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' (Mark 12:30)

LOVING OTHERS FLOWS FROM LOVING GOD . The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." (Mark 12:31)

DEEP LOVE FLOWS FROM DEEP FORGIVENESS. For this reason I say to you, her sins, which are many, have been forgiven, for she loved much; but the one who is forgiven little, loves little." (Luke 7:47)

DEEP LOVE IS FOCUSED, NOT DIVIDED. No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth." (Luke 26:13)

DEEP LOVE IS SELFLESS AND SACRIFICIAL. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

DEEP LOVE IS THE HALLMARK OF TRUE DISCIPLES. I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another; just as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all people will know that you are My disciples: if you have love for one another. (John 13:34-35)

DEEP LOVE LEADS TO LOVING OBEDIENCE. Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will follow My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our dwelling with him. (John 14:23)

DEEP LOVE FLOWS FROM GOD THROUGH CHRIST. Just as the Father has loved Me, I also have loved you; remain in My love. (John 15:9)

DEEP LOVE IS FORGOTTEN WHEN WE DISOBEY. If you keep My commandments, you will remain in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and remain in His love. (John 15:10)

DEEP LOVE REMAINS EVEN IF WE SIN. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

DEEP LOVE ENDURES IN TIMES OF TROUBLE. Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or trouble, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? (Romans 8:35)

DEEP LOVE PREVAILS AGAINST ALL CHALLENGES. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 5:38-39)

DEEP LOVE OPENS DOORS TO MUCH MORE. Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, And which have not entered the human heart, All that God has prepared for those who love Him." (I Corinthians 2:9)

DEEP LOVE HAS MANY FACES: Love is **patient**, love is **kind**, it is **not jealous**; love does **not brag**, it is **not arrogant**. (I Cor. 13:4)

DEEP LOVE NEVER FAILS: (Love) **every confidence**, it **believes all things**, **hopes all things**, **endures all things**.

Grace

GRACE AND GLORY ARE FROM GOD For the Lord God is a sun and shield; **The Lord gives grace and glory;** No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly. Psalm 84:11

GRACE SPAWNS SALVATION THROUGH FAITH **For by grace you have been saved through faith;** and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. Ephesians 2:8-9

GRACE IS NOT ON THE BASIS OF WORKS In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to God's gracious choice. **But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.** Romans 11:5-6

GRACE IS A GIFT THAT JUSTIFIES THE REDEEMED For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **being justified as a gift by His grace** through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24

GRACE UPON GRACE COMES FROM HIS FULLNESS For of His fullness we have all received and **grace upon grace.** For the Law was given through Moses; **grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.** John 1:16-17

GRACE IS GOD'S CHANNEL OF ABUNDANCE And God is able to **make all grace abound to you,** so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed; 2 Corinthians 9:8

GRACE DEFINES AND WORKS THROUGH US **But by the grace of God I am what I am,** and His grace toward me did not prove vain; **but I labored even more** than all of them, **yet not I, but the grace of God with me.** 1 Corinthians 15:10

GRACE SPAWNS DIFFERENT GIFTS IN DIFFERENT DEGREES Since we have **gifts that differ according to the grace given to us,** each of us is to exercise them accordingly: Romans 12:6

GRACE EMPOWERS WONDERS AND SIGNS THROUGH US And Stephen, **full of grace and power,** was performing great wonders and signs among the people. Acts 6:8

GRACE COMES TO THE HUMBLE, NOT THE PROUD But **He gives a greater grace.** Therefore it says, "God is **opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble.**" James 4:6

GRACE IS TO GROW WITHIN US **Grow in the grace and knowledge** of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 3:18

GRACE IS SUFFICIENT FOR ANY WEAKNESS IN US "**My grace is sufficient for you,** for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. 2 Cor. 12:9

GRACE HEALS HEARTS OF BITTERNESS See to it that no one comes **short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness** springing up causes trouble, and by it many be defiled; Hebrews 12:15

GRACE REIGNS THROUGH RIGHTEOUSNESS The Law came in so that the transgression would increase; but **where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,** so that, as sin reigned in death, even so **grace would reign through righteousness** to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 5:21-22

GRACE PROVIDES HOPE AND ETERNAL COMFORT Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and **given us eternal comfort and good hope by grace,** 2 Thessalonians 2:16

Oneness

ONE WITH EACH OTHER AS GOD AND CHRIST. I am no longer in the world; and yet they themselves are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, the name which You have given Me, that they may be one even as We are. (John 17:11)

ONE WITH GOD AND CHRIST AS A TESTIMONY. "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word; 21 that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. . (John 17:20-21)

ONE WITH GOD AND CHRIST IN UNITY. The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; 23 I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me. (John 17:22-23)

ONE WITH CHRIST WITH A NEW LIFE. For if we have become united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; 7 for he who has died is freed from sin. (Rom. 6:5-6)

ONE WITH CHRIST IN EARTHLY LIFE. Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him... 11 Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus (Romans 6:8, 11)

ONE WITH CHRIST IN ETERNAL LIFE. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

ONE WITH CHRIST TO BEAR FRUIT. Therefore, my brethren, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God. (Romans 7:4)

ONE IN NEWNESS OF THE SPIRIT. Therefore, But now we have been released from the Law, having died to that by which we were bound, so that we serve in newness of the Spirit and not in oldness of the letter. (Romans 7:6)

ONE IN CHRIST AS A NEW CREATION. Therefore if anyone is in Christ, [h]e is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. (2 Corinthians 5:17)

ONE FROM DEATH TO LIFE IN CHRIST. But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, (Eph. 2:4-6)

ONE WITH CHRIST LIKE A HUSBAND AND WIFE. FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH. 32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. (Ephesians 5:31-32)

I AM - A Child of God (Romans 8:16) *The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God ...*

I AM - A New Creation (II Cor. 5:17) *Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation . . .*

I AM - A Justified Saint (Romans 5:1) *Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God ...*

I AM - A Sanctified Saint (Acts 26:18) *Receive forgiveness of sins.. (f0r) you have been sanctified by faith in Me.*

I AM - A Forgiven Sinner (Colossians 1:13,14) *He rescued us (in) His beloved Son... (with) the forgiveness of sins.*

I AM - A Freed Slave (John 8:36) *So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.*

I AM - A Protected Traveler (Psalm 91:11) *For He will give His angels charge concerning you, to guard you in all your ways.*

I AM - A Healed Patient (I Peter 2:24) *He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross ... for by His wounds you were healed.*

I AM - An Eternal Heir (Rom. 8:16-17) *We are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ...*

I AM - An Empowered Believer 4:13) *I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.*

I AM - A Reflected Light (Matthew 5:14) *Let your light shine before men (with) good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.*

I AM - A Conquering Soldier (Romans 8:37) *But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.*

I AM - A Daily Overcomer (I John 4:4) *(You) have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.*

I AM - A Grace Receiver (Eph. 2:8) *For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God*

I AM - A Jesus Trustor (I Peter 5:7) *Humble yourselves . . . casting all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you.*

I AM - A Divine Partaker (II Peter 1:4) *He has granted to us His precious promises that you may become partakers of the divine nature...*

I AM - A God Praiser (Psalm 34:1) *I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.*

I AM - A Reigning Servant (Romans 5:17) *Those who receive the abundance of grace ... will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.*

I AM - A Redeemed Captive (Psa. 107:2) *Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the adversary.*

I AM - A Rescued Prisoner (Colossians 1:13) *He rescued us from the domain of darkness... to the kingdom of His beloved Son.*

I AM - An Abrahamic Heir (Galatians 3:13, 14) *Christ redeemed us ... in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come ...*

I AM - A Blessed Believer (Eph. 1:3) *Blessed be (our) Father ... who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places ...*

I AM - A Delegated Authority (Luke 10:19) *I have given you authority ... over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you.*

I AM - A Truth Bearer (Matthew 16:19) *(The keys) whatever you bind (or loose) on earth shall have been bound (or loosed) in heaven...*

I AM - A Cleansed Overcomer (Rev. 12:11) *And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb ...*

I AM - A Grateful Overcomer (Rev. 12:11) *And they overcame him ... because of the word of their testimony...*

I AM - A Faith Walker (II Corinthians 5:7-8) *For we walk by faith, not by sight— are of good courage ...*

I AM - A Thought Checker (II Corinthians 10:5) *We are destroying speculations ... taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.*

I AM - A Transformed Disciple (Romans 12:2) *Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind...*

I AM - A Righteous Christian (II Cor. 5:21) *He made Him ... to be sin... so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.*

I AM - A Grateful Laborer (Deut. 28:12) *The LORD will open for you ... the heavens ... to bless all the work of your hand*

I AM - A Blessed Follower (Deuteronomy 28:6) *Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out*

I AM - A Guided Soul (Romans 8:14) *For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.*
