Christian Conduct:

Our camp maintains high standards of Christian conduct. Separate water game times are scheduled for boys and girls. The camp reserves the right to set standards of conduct, such as: boy/girl relations, dress standards, response to authority, etc. Campers who violate these standards are subject to dismissal at parents' expense.

Medical Information & Insurance:

The medical/insurance information must be completed on the registration form. Please note that our insurance will be submitted as secondary. Your insurance will be considered the primary insurance in case of an accident or injury.

Dress Standards:

All clothing must be loose fitting and cover the body from shoulders to the middle of the knee. For recreation — girls and boys may wear loose fitting sports clothes that come to the middle of the knee. For preaching — boys will wear shirts with collars — girls will wear a skirt or dress. Campers must remove body piercings except girls with pierced ears. The camp reserves the right to require any camper to change their clothing if it is deemed inappropriate.

Parents Notes:

- 1.) Campers are expected to stay the entire week except for sickness or emergency.
- 2.) We have an extremely full schedule which is difficult to interrupt for phone calls/visits.
- 3.) Campers are not permitted to use the phone except in emergencies.
