
# Child Development Home Capacity - Category A

No more than 6 children above this line.



Maximum capacity of 12. These include the provider's own infant, preschool, and home-schooled children.





In cases of inclement weather or emergency school closing, an assistant at least 18 years of age must be present if more than 8 children.

Category C - One Provider One provider alone may care for no more than 8 children with no more than 3 children less than 18 months old.



No more than 3 children above this line with one provider. If there are 4 children under 18 months, both providers must be present.

















No more than 12 children above this line.



Less than 2 hours.



No more than 180 hours combined.

Additional children in part-time care may not place provider over infant & toddler limits.
