1. Basic Information

- Event Name : Kuala Lumpur Starlight International Youth Art Selection Competition
- Competition Stages:
 - ➤ Preliminary Round (Online): March 1 June 30, 2025 (Video Submission)
 - Finals (Sabah): 17-22 July 2025 (Onsite Competition)
 - Exhibition Performance (Sabah): 17-22 July 2025 (Onsite Performance)
- Venue: To be announced on the official website.

2. Competition Rules

Preliminary Round (Online):

- 2.1 Eligibility
- Global Participation: Open to contestants from 30+ countries/regions (individuals or groups).
- Category Requirements: Participants must register according to competition categories and age groups.

2.2 Schedule

- **Submission Window:** April 1 June 30, 2025
- Qualification Announcement: Real-time evaluation (Contestants scoring ≥60 points will advance immediately).

3. Video Submission Rules

Duration Limit : Individual: ≤2 minutes , Group: ≤3.5 minutes

Video Requirements : Landscape MP4 format, clear resolution. No editing or special

effects; single continuous shot.

Naming Convention : Format_Individual/Group_Category_GroupName

Example:

Youth_Individual_Dance_ABC

JuniorGroupB_Group_Music_XYZ

(Upload to the official platform.)

4. Advancement Mechanism

• Quota: Global limit of 500 entries (registration closes once full).

• Advancement: Qualifies for Finals registration.

5. Fee Structure

Individual : USD 25 per person

Group : Base fee USD 25 per group + USD 10 per additional member

6. Preliminary Round Awards

• All participants receive an e-cert.

7. Advancement Notification

- Submissions receive feedback within 7 working days.
- Successful qualifiers are notified via email.
- Ensure accurate email and phone number; check spam folders regularly.

8.3 Judging Criteria:

Judge Category

Music :Technical Skill (30%), Creativity & Concept (30%), Stage Performance (30%),

Emotional Expression (10%)

Vocal :Technical Skill (30%), Creativity & Concept (30%), Stage Performance (30%),

Emotional Expression (10%)

Dance :Technical Difficulty (30%), Creativity & Concept (30%), Stage Performance

(30%), Emotional Expression (10%)

Others :Technical Difficulty (30%), Creativity & Concept (30%), Stage Performance

(30%), Emotional Expression (10%)

Criteria Details:

- i. Technical Skill: Fundamentals, accuracy, power, control.
- ii. Creativity & Concept: Choreography, originality, design.
- iii. Stage Performance: Presentation, lighting/sound effects, costumes/props.
- iv. Emotional Expression: Emotion conveyance, body language, facial expressions.

9. Advancement Benefits and Rules

Preliminary Stage

- All participants will receive a **Participation Certificate**.
- o Qualified contestants will be awarded an **Official Finals Invitation**.

Finals Stage

- O Three-tier Honor Awards (based on scoring):
- Gold Award (80 points and above) | Silver Award (70 points and above) | Bronze Award (60 points and above)
- O Winners of each tier will receive customized medals and certificates.
- o Participants below the award threshold will receive a Finals Participation Certificate.
- O All awarded teams automatically qualify as candidates for the **Showcase Session**.
- O Special prizes include gemstone gift packages worth millions and Creative Fund Vouchers.

Showcase Session

o The judging panel will select teams demonstrating outstanding artistic expression and high creative execution from the awarded groups, granting them stage performance eligibility.
