CANICA A.C. has been a pioneer in comprehensive care for childhood cancer, implementing key programs focused on the family and complementing the needs of the child that hospitals cannot cover, such as medications, transportation, psychosocial support. CANICA A.C. does everything to ensure a timely diagnosis, complete treatment, and reduce the consequences that cancer has left in children, thus increasing the survival rate in Western Mexico.



To provide comprehensive support to children and young people with cancer who are currently being treated in public hospitals, respecting their natural dignity as a person.

We provide advice to families so that each member can respond skillfully to the situation of illness.

Centro de Rehabilitación

Its main objective is to provide comprehensive and quality oncological rehabilitation to children and adolescents diagnosed with cancer through a program that considers care from the early stages of diagnosis and treatment.

The side effects of treatments and sequelae can affect up to 80% of survivors, so managing and knowing prevention and rehabilitation tools becomes imperative for this population to reduce the long-term impact of the disease.

CANICA DINING ROOMS

CANICA operates three dining rooms so that parents can have hot, nutritious, tasty food with care and hygiene at the time they can go downstairs and leave their child in the care of someone else, all of this free of charge.

In addition to providing food, warmth, hope, comfort, accompaniment, attentive listening, psychological support, and love for life are offered, so that they can focus only on caring for their child.



It is very difficult to give a parent the news that their child has cancer, but it is even harder to hear the phrase "there is nothing more to do." It generates fear, hopelessness, frustration and helplessness, among others, which affects not only the well-being of the child, but also that of the entire family.

Our program is centered on the principle that "there is always something more to do" and we invite children to enjoy life, offering support to them and their families, relief from pain and other physical, psycho-emotional and spiritual problems, caring for the caregiver by giving them space to rest and continue standing up to care for those they love so much, support during death and grief, and the creation of memories and legacies that last forever.

CANICA A.C. brings care with humanism, warmth and tenderness, our program helps keep families together in adversity, offers them tools to make decisions in difficult times and creates memories that transcend life, managing to calm and heal the souls of families regardless of the outcome, thus giving life to their days, helping children to live fully until the moment of their departure.







At CANICA we recognize that children with cancer are part of a family system, therefore, in order for them to find health, the family needs to find order, love and respect.

We provide tools with our psychotherapy protocol to ensure that the family remains united.

To achieve this, we care for Mom and Dad, as well as siblings, who, although they do not have the disease, require special attention to their needs.



For CANICA A.C. it is of utmost importance to be facilitators and guides for parents in decision making, and Social Work is the area of first contact with them. It allows us to know the needs they face due to their child's illness and constitutes a bridge between families, CANICA A.C., the hospital and other aid organizations.

It channels the needs of our users, generates internal communication for the coordinators of the CANICA programs, following up on the coverage and support provided to each family.

Through this department, we are able to support with:

- PET
- Prosthetics
- Food supplies
- Support with surgical material

- Transportation
- Wheelchairs
- Laboratory tests
- Oncology medications

- Adjuvant medications
- CBD
- Home palliative care







When children are diagnosed with some type of cancer, a cascade of emotions are generated within them and their families, even more so when they begin to lose many things such as playing, going to school, etc.

During the treatment, the child is subjected to countless hospitalizations, outpatient chemotherapy, radiation, surgeries, endless studies and the injections are throughout the whole process.

Given this scenario, CANICA A.C. proposes to create moments of recreation for the child and his family, CANICA moments. It is not about forgetting about the disease, but rather managing to offer moments of joy and happiness during adversity.

MEDICINE FOR THE

NEURODEVELOPMENT

Minimize the consequences caused by damage in premature and full-term children who have left the neonatal intensive care units of the Guadalajara Metropolitan Area.

We offer early stimulation to children under 3 years of age with a high risk of developmental delay, candidates include:

- Jaundice
- Premature birth
- Meningitis
- Septicemia
- Intraventricular hemorrhage
- Hypoxic ischemic encephalopathy
- Survivors of cardiorespiratory arrest
- Prolonged stay in intensive care units







We provide families of children with cancer and other illnesses with lodging when they need to travel to Guadalajara or San Luis Potosí. It is "A Home Away from Home" during their treatment.

We offer free lodging for children and caregivers, as well as food and transportation, including transfers to their medical appointments.

In the absence of support networks, we are committed to being that essential support, allowing them to focus on what is most important: the child's recovery.


