

Develop a visual journal documenting dialogue on future of health

- **Goals:** 1) Inspire creative thinking, 2) Reveal patterns that generate insights for future forecasting, 3) Provide participants with a visual memory of the event – that represents the roadmap focused on connecting technology leaders with grassroots organization working to harness A.I. and enabling technologies to address health equity and related challenges.

Methods (simultaneous):

- **Live Murals Building:** Visual journalist creates murals on 4 x 6-foot paper on the walls of the conference room, documenting the discussion in words and images.
- **Automated Tapestries:** The Tapestry app produces automated digital pictures, using our A.I. technology to replicate the live mural method with algorithms that extract main ideas and group sentiment.
