ITINERARY

Dramatic island silhouettes, steady trade winds, and classic Caribbean anchorages set the tone in the British Virgin Islands. It's a destination designed for smooth sailing and perfectly paced island hopping.

Short sails lead to hiking trails, beach stops, snorkeling spots, and legendary island hangouts—easygoing adventure at every turn.



COOPER ISLAND

Our first stop in the BVI, Cooper Island is home to the laid-back Cooper Island Beach Club. An ideal place to meet your crew, get settled aboard, and ease into island life.



THE BATHS

One of the BVI's most iconic stops, The Baths is known for its massive granite boulders, hidden grottos, and a scenic trail that winds through the formations and along the coast.



BITTER END

A legendary stop in North Sound, Bitter End Yacht Club has long been a gathering place for sailors, offering a lively atmosphere and classic island energy.



GUANA ISLAND

Known for its unspoiled terrain and peaceful atmosphere, Guana Island is a refreshing contrast to the busier stops of the BVI.



JOST VAN DYKE

A favorite stop for sailors, Jost Van Dyke is known for its world-famous beach bars, live music, and unforgettable nights ashore.



NORMAN ISLAND

HOW IT WORKS

IT'S EASIER THAN YOU THINK.

At Share the Sail, we believe that sailing should be more than just a vacation—it should be an unforgettable experience shared with like-minded adventurers. Whether you've sailed before or you're brand new to life on the water, our flotilla-style getaways are designed to be welcoming, low-pressure, and packed with connection and discovery.

BOOK YOUR CABIN

Choose between a single or double occupancy cabin aboard a 42-51' catamaran. Each boat features 4-6 cabins, each with a private bathroom (head), and is crewed by a licensed captain provided by us. No sailing experience? No problem—just bring your sense of adventure.

GET MATCHED WITH YOUR CREW

Once you book, you'll complete a quick personality and preference form. Our team uses this to match you with fellow guests who we think you'll click with. Couples, friends, and solo travelers are all welcome.

JOIN THE COMMUNITY

You'll gain access to a private online portal where you can upload documents, connect with your future crew, attend "Meet the Guests" calls, and ask questions at our weekly open Zoom office hours. We also host live webinars for those still gathering info before they book.

PROVISIONING & PLANNING

We'll take care of provisioning your boat with breakfast, lunch, snacks, and water. You'll coordinate with your crew if you want to bring extras like soda or beer. Dinners are enjoyed ashore at local island restaurants—one of the highlights of the experience!

SAIL, EXPLORE, AND CONNECT

Once you arrive, just show up, hop aboard, and enjoy the ride. Each day brings a new destination, from quiet coves to snorkeling hot spots. While each boat sails independently, we meet up for theme nights, beach bonfires, and group dinners. You'll end the week with sun-kissed memories and lifelong friends.



LIFE ONBOARD WITH SHARE THE SAIL

Life aboard a Share the Sail trip is laid-back, exciting, and community-driven. You'll be sailing through turquoise waters with a small flotilla of like-minded adventurers—each catamaran has 4-6 private cabins (each with its own head), and every boat comes with a professional captain. No sailing experience is required—you can learn as much or as little as you'd like.

Your mornings start with breakfast on deck, followed by island-hopping, snorkeling, or simply soaking up the sun. Each boat sets sail at a similar pace, anchoring together in stunning locations by late afternoon. You'll explore charming cays, snorkel world-class reefs, and have the freedom to go at your own pace.

Evenings can be spent dining ashore at dock-up restaurants, hosting a happy hour with neighboring boats, or joining one of our casual theme nights. You'll meet new friends, trade stories, and enjoy the best of the cruising lifestyle—without needing to plan a thing.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

GETTING THERE

Fly into Terrance B. Lettsome Airport, British Virgin Islands (EIS) in Tortola. This is the closest airport to the base, 16.6 km (about 35 minutes) from the Nanny Cay Marina.

However, you also have the option to fly into Cyril E. King Airport, St Thomas, USVI (STT) and Ferry, 1hr to Road Town, BVI. Road Town is 8.4 km (about 18 minutes) from the Nanny Cay Marina

THE BASE/ CHECK IN

Our trip begins and ends at The Nanny Cay Marina, located at Sea Cow Bay, Sir Francis Drake Hwy, British Virgin Islands.

- GPS: 18.398° N, 64.6341° W
- Check-In: 6pm
- Check-Out: 9am

SHUTTLE SERVICE

We provide free shuttle transportation on arrival day from the airport to the marina base. If you're staying at a hotel within 10–15 minutes of the base, we can also arrange pickup—just let us know in advance.

ARRIVE EARLY, RELAX EASY

We strongly recommend arriving the day before your charter begins. There are several nearby hotels and Airbnb options in Tortola. Guest favorites include:

- Nanny Cay Resort & Marina
- The Moorings Yacht Club Hotel

PASSPORTS & CUSTOMS

All travelers must carry a valid passport with at least 6 months of validity beyond your return date. U.S. and Canadian citizens do not need a visa for visits under 90 days. You must clear customs upon entry—check with us to ensure you're prepared with proper documents.

GROCERY STOP

Before boarding, we recommend a stop at RiteWay Food Markets, just a few minutes from Road Town. This is your best opportunity to grab alcohol, snacks, and other essentials. Depending on arrival times, the shuttle can drop you off en route. Taxis are also readily available—only about a 9-minute ride.



Share the sail is an experience that embodies the spirit of adventure. It is a wonderful opportunity to enjoy the freedom of spending a week on a private boat sailing crystal blue waters and visiting exotic islands and anchorages with new and experienced sailors. It is a well organized and designed week of sailing adventures we look forward to year after year.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHERE DO I SLEEP?

Each guest or couple has their own private cabin with a double bed and en-suite bathroom (head). You'll be sharing the catamaran with other like-minded guests, but your cabin is all yours.

WILL I BE ABLE TO SHOWER DAILY?

Yes, each cabin includes a private bathroom with a shower. That said, fresh water is limited on board, so quick showers are encouraged.

DO I NEED SAILING EXPERIENCE?

Not at all! Every boat has a professional licensed captain. You can learn to sail—or just relax with a cocktail in hand.

ARE MEALS INCLUDED?

Provisioning includes breakfast, lunch, snacks, and water. Dinner is not included—most nights we anchor near a town or beach bar so you can enjoy dining ashore. Alcohol and soft drinks are not included.

WHAT EXTRA COSTS SHOULD I EXPECT?

Shared expenses like fuel and mooring fees are split among your boat's crew. We estimate about \$100–\$200 per person. Tips for the captain (usually 15–20%) are appreciated.

WILL I BE RANDOMLY ASSIGNED TO A BOAT?

Nope! We use a custom matching process based on your personality form and preferences. We'll also host virtual meetups so you can meet others before the trip.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I GET SICK OR INJURED?

There are basic first aid kits on board, and we strongly recommend travel insurance that covers medical evacuation, just in case.

HOW DO WE GET TO SHORE?

Every catamaran has a dinghy for getting to and from land. Your captain will handle the trips!
