

The Los Angeles Tribune Global Magicians Hall of Fame Awards



The Los Angeles Tribune's Global Magic Hall of Fame Awards: A Celebration of Excellence.

On July 9th, a gathering of esteemed magicians and enthusiasts converged on Las Vegas for the inaugural **Global Magic Hall of Fame Awards**, sponsored by the *Los Angeles Tribune*. The event, expertly produced by Tim Wise with significant contributions from Connie Boyd, was a testament to the art of magic.

The evening commenced with a captivating card manipulation performance by Stephane Vanel, showcasing his remarkable skill and stage presence. Vanel's artistry left a lasting impression, and it's clear that his career is on the rise.







Following Vanel's performance, host Tim Wise welcomed the audience and introduced the first award, the Media Excellence Award, which was presented to Paul Romhany for his outstanding work on Vanish International Magic Magazine. As someone who has had the pleasure of working with Romhany for nearly 14 years, I was delighted to accept the award on his behalf, acknowledging his tireless dedication and vision.

The Innovation Award was subsequently presented to Connie Boyd, recognizing her efforts in highlighting the contributions of female magicians to the industry. Margaret Steele received the Literary Award, expressing her gratitude through a heartfelt video message.

The evening's festivities continued with Steve Owens' mesmerizing shadow magic performance, which reimagined this delightful art form.

The awards ceremony proceeded with the Performance Achievement Award being presented to Jan Kramer, fol-

lowed by the Rising Star Award, which was bestowed upon Jake Hofman by Diana Zimmerman and me. Other notable award recipients included Lynette Chappell, who received the Contribution to Community Philanthropy Award; Kevin James was recognized for his Inventive Performance.

Benjamin Barnes was honored for his Contribution to Magic Philanthropy. Mistie and Kyle Knight accepted the Influencing Social Media Award. This mega-talented couple also gave us a taste of their smooth and slick show. Next, Luna Shimada received the Adelaide Herrmann Award. She also performed part of her award-winning show. As always, Luna rocked the room!

In a pre-recorded message, Margaret Steele presented the Houdini Award to Dorothy Dietrich. Moe Rock, CEO of the Los Angeles Tribune, took the stage to share his vision behind creating the Global Magic Hall of Fame, followed by the presentation of the G.O.A.T. Award to Criss Angel.







The evening culminated with the induction of the **2025 Hall of Fame** recipients. **Allan Ackerman** presented the award to Howard Hamburg, the legendary card worker and highly deserving recipient of this recognition. Howard is the card man who has been a wonderful presence, and Ambassador in the world of magic. His sleight of hand is breathtaking, but his collection of stories and memories of the golden years, when Vernon, Miller, and Jennings might be sitting at the same table.

The next inductee to the Magic Hall of Fame was **Gay Blackstone.** Gay is a force of nature and knows magic inside and out. For many years, Gay toured with her esteemed husband and world-class magician, Harry Blackstone Jr. Gay went on to be the Executive Producer of the long-running Masters of Illusion television show on the CW Network.

Fielding West is a true legend in the world of comedy magic. Fielding has made me laugh on so many occasions that I
