Our YEA Youth President is David Kissell. He and the other youth are working on ground school subjects and are inviting several different schools to come and discuss the schools programs on a monthly basis.



New FAA Certificates Now Available

All paper airmen certificates will be invalid as of 31 MAR 2010. Those need to updated to plastic.

Pilots should be aware that their current Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) pilot certificates will expire on March 31, 2010. New counterfeit-resistant plastic certificates are now available from the FAA. The cost is \$2 to replace a paper certificate with a plastic certificate.

Processing by mail takes 4-6 weeks and online processing takes up to 10 days. Some non-pilot certificates, such as those for flight engineers and mechanics, are good for another three years but then they will also have to be replaced. Student certificates are not affected. Pilots can also ask the FAA to issue a new certificate number that does not match their Social Security number.
