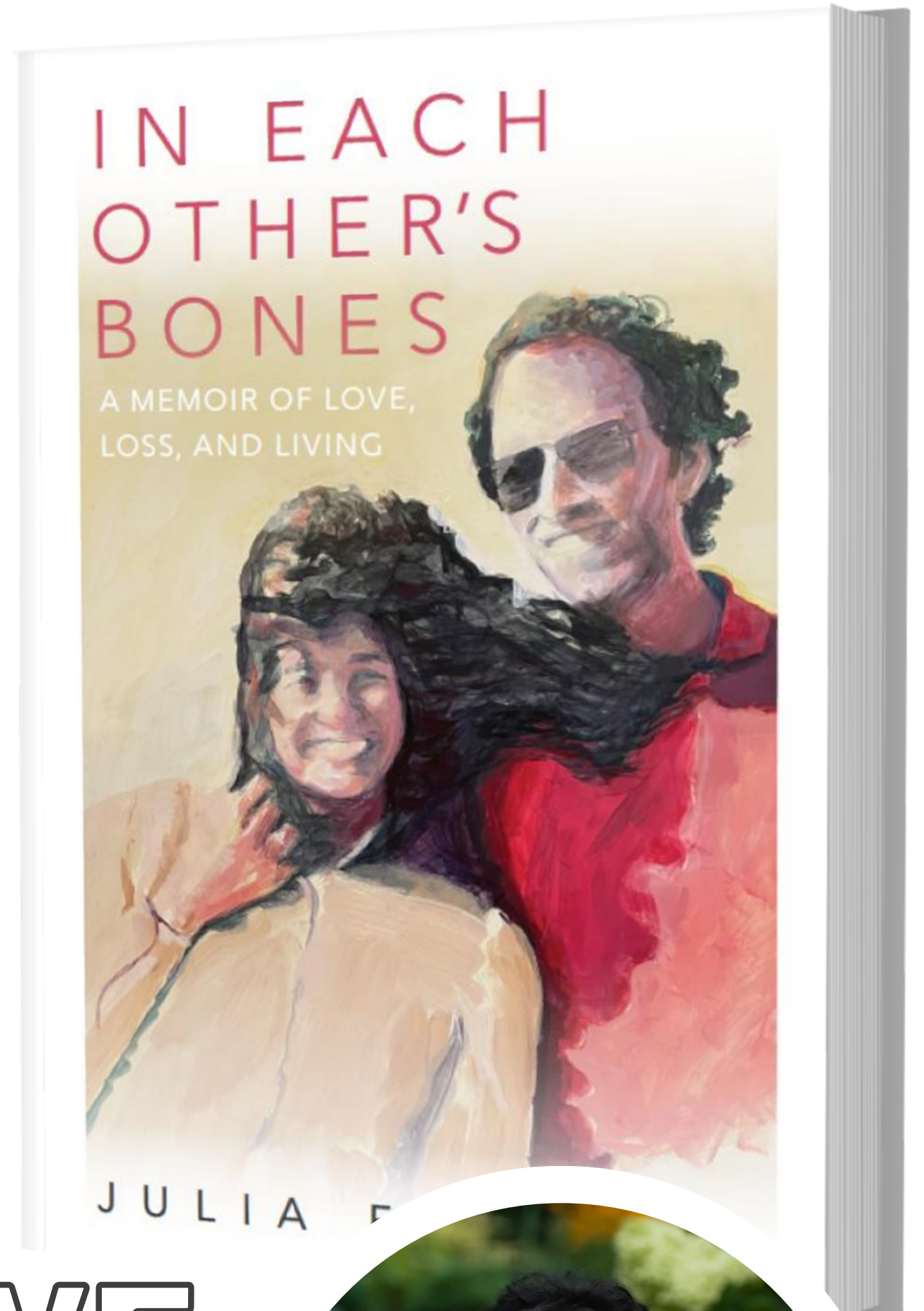

The Author

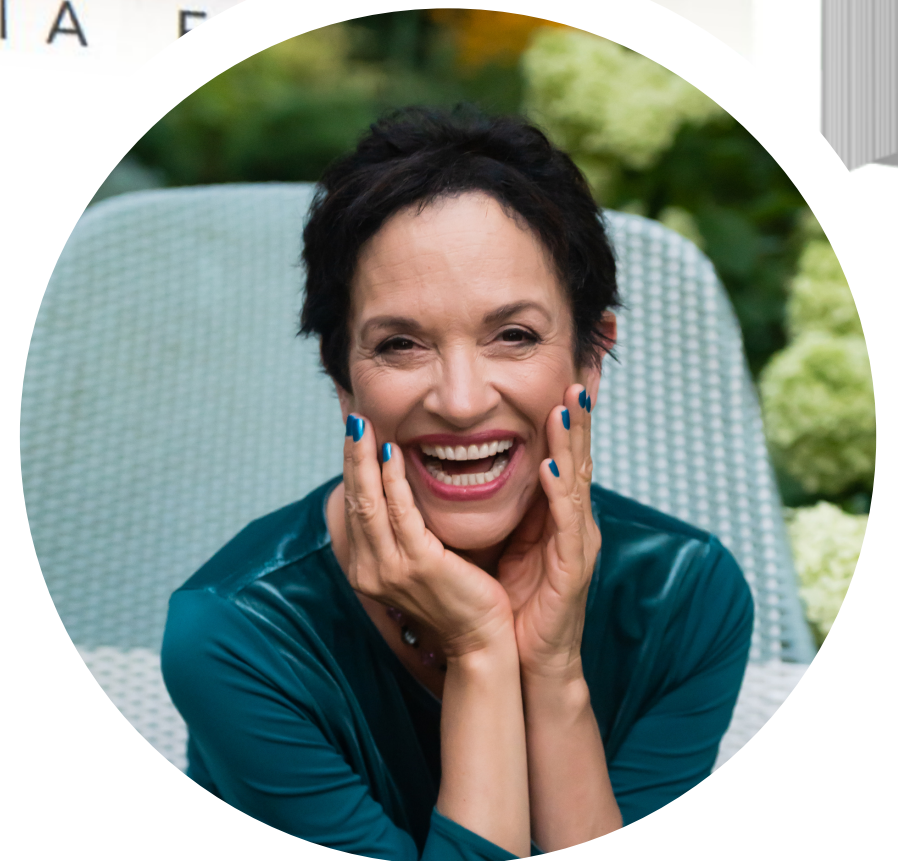
