



Challenge Bonuses

TO USE A CONTRAST COLOR YARN FOR YOUR HEEL FLAP:

Change to your CC as you work the ssk at the end of Row 1.

Then, cut your MC yarn leaving a tail to weave in during finishing

EYE OF PARTRIDGE HEEL FLAP:

Now you will work the heel flap and gusset stitches together with decrease sts, reducing your stitch count as you go until you have 13 sts remaining on Needle 2:

Row 1 (RS): SM as you work, *sl 1 purlwise wyib, k1; repeat from * until 1 st remains before the gap, ssk. Turn your work. (1 st dec).

Row 2 (WS): SM as you work, sl 1 purlwise wyif, purl until 1 st remains before the gap, p2tog. Turn your work. (1 st dec)

Row 3: SM as you work, sl 2 purlwise wyib, *k1, sl 1 purlwise wyib; repeat until 1 st remains before the gap, ssk. Turn your work. (1 st dec).

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Continue working Rows 1-4 until you have completed working all the heel flap stitches with your gusset stitches.

You will have 13 stitches on Needle 2.

Next, knit to end of Needle 2.

ROUNDED TOE:

CAST ON:

With circular needles and CC, cast on 8 sts using the Turkish Cast-On Method:

4 sts will become your sole/heel sts, and 4 sts will become your instep sts.

KNIT THE TOE:

Round 1 (RS):

Needle 1: K1, PM for BOR, M1R, knit until 1 st remains, M1L, k1. (6 sts)

Needle 2: K1, M1R, k1, PM, k1, M1L, k1. (6 sts)
(4 sts inc, 12 sts total)

Round 2:

Needle 1: K1, SM, M1R, knit until 1 st remains, M1L, k1.

Needle 2: K1, M1R, k1, SM, k1, M1L, k1.
(4 sts inc, 16 sts total)

Round 3: Repeat Row 2.
(4 sts inc, 20 sts total)

Round 4: Repeat Row 2.
(4 sts inc, 24 sts total)

Rounds 6-8: Knit all sts without increasing.

Then, follow the original pattern instructions.
