## What is MFA

MFA stands for Multi-Factor Authentication, a security enhancement that requires two or more methods of verification to access an account.

## Why MFA

MFA enhances security by requiring multiple methods of verification, making it harder for attackers to access accounts with just a stolen password.


## What this means

With Microsoft Authenticator, MFA works by sending a notification to the user's smartphone or tablet to verify their identity when prompted for Multi-Factor Authentication. The user approves the notification to complete the verification process
