### Day 20 - Tel Aviv & social impact

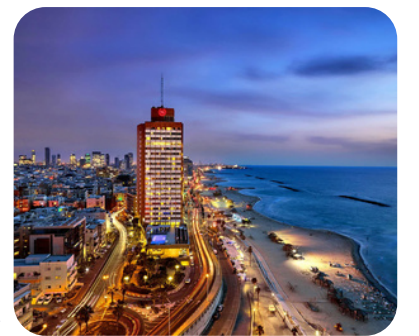
Guided tour of Independence Hall

Machtesh Gadol crater tour

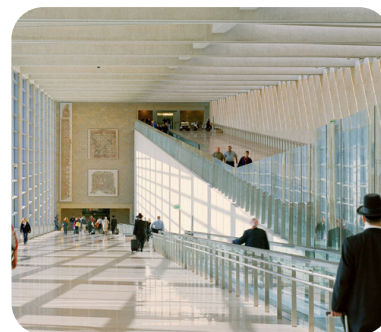

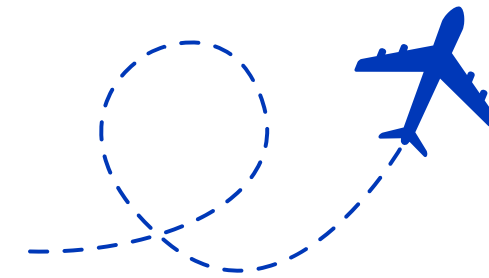
