Highly significant event in support of the Breast Reconstruction Program of the Civil Hospital of Guadalajara, which has been held annually during the month of October since 2013, within the framework of the Inter-institutional Campaign to Fight Breast Cancer, with the participation, as models, of 20 women survivors of breast cancer.

In addition to sending a message of encouragement to other women who are going through this serious problem of health, by demonstrating that breast cancer can be overcome and a better quality of life can be achieved with comprehensive care, including breast reconstruction.

Breast cancer is the most common cancer among women around the world and represents 16% of all female cancers.

Every year, 1.5 million new cases are reported worldwide, of which approximately half occur in developed countries.

In Mexico it represents the first cause of death in women due to malignant tumors. On average, 15 Mexican women die from this delicate disease per day, that is, one Mexican every two hours.


Subject: Follow-up to the decision of the Economic and Social Council






