When you support our signature events, you make a impact for youth mentorship in Ventura County.

- It costs an annual average of \$1,800 for BBSVC to support a Big & Little or a Youth Leader in our programs. ...and an additional average of \$1,000 to recruit, screen, train, and match each of the right volunteers!

 This cost supports professional case management our case managers maintain ongoing (minimum monthly) contact with every Little, Big, Parent/Guardian, and other youth in the home to ensure the highest standards of youth safety. They also identify family needs and ensure participants are connected to resources that help. Matches must also participate in ongoing training around safety topics like opioid awareness, mental health support, and much more.
- Title sponsorships help us cover the costs of the event...AND drive awareness about our volunteer needs. Sponsorships offset the costs of hosting an event like venue, food, entertainment, and materials ensuring that more of the funds raised directly support BBSVC's youth mentoring programs. But in addition to financial support, event sponsorships deliver a powerful platform to increase awareness about our organization's impact and ongoing needs, curating a space where BBSVC can highlight the urgent need for volunteer mentors, amplifying our call to action, and connecting us with new individuals and networks who are eager to make a difference in a young person's life. In short, event sponsors don't just make the event possible they expand our reach and fuel the future of our mission.
- Recruitment of volunteers happens before, during, AND after the event.

Volunteer recruitment is deeply connected to our fundraising events - before, during, and after. Pre-event marketing builds local brand awareness, introducing our mission to broader audiences. At the event itself, powerful storytelling and opportunities to connect with mentors and youth inspire guests to take action. Partnerships formed and conversations sparked during the event create a ripple effect that drives volunteer sign-ups and sustained engagement over time. Every dollar invested and raised through the event keeps working for months afterwards, helping us recruit, train, and support mentors right here in our communities.
