Utility Box Art Deadline: September 1

Utility Box Art Project, Bullhead AZ

Managed by The River Valley Artist Guild through a partnership and funded by Bullhead City

The Utility Box Art Project (UBA) goal is to create a unified look for the stoplight boxes in Bullhead City. The artist will design the box for the area where it is located, for example, a sports theme by the Optimum Center location. All artwork should fit into the Bullhead image. The project is open to all Members of the River Valley Artist Guild. We will be painting in the fall/winter months below 90 degrees.

- 1. The artist is responsible for providing artwork and how it will appear on the boxes
- 2. The design cannot cover utility box identification numbers, codes, keyholes, meter boxes or handles. The art cannot restrict vents or airflow through the boxes. City maintenance crews must be able to access the components inside the box fully at all times.
- 3. The design cannot include any breach of intellectual property, copywriting, brands, images of illegal activity, or attach objects to the box.
- 4. RVAG can change location and reserves the right to recommend revisions to submitted work.
- 5. RVAG All metal adhesive paint provided. Basic colors provided, you will have to mix the colors you need.
- 6. RVGA Provides paint, drop cloths, rags, buckets, and brushes.
- 7. RVGA Each design will be finalized with an anti-graffiti clear coat
- 8. Artwork may not extend onto the surrounding asphalt roadway, sidewalk, etc.
- 9. The artist is welcome to sign the piece, but the signature can be no larger than a 3" x 5" area and must be near the bottom of the box per area.
- 10. Contract and Liability: An artist cannot begin painting the selected utility box until all liability and contract forms are completed and submitted to RVAG, and the design has been approved.
- 11. The artist or other painting professionals may complete painting the artwork.
- 12. Bullhead City retains all rights for the artwork submitted.
- 13. Duration: Utility Box Art Projects shall be on public display for a recommended period of four years; after that, the selected piece of infrastructure would be eligible for a new design or repainted to its original color.
- 14. Not all submittions will be accepted by the City. They approve the design and location.

Materials submitted will not be returned; please do not provide originals. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
