Other Considerations:

Completion of approved training program including 360 hours of training (210 theory/150 practical), chair side supervision under a licensed tattoo artist. Must have documentation showing a minimum of 50 completed procedures (which means "a tattoo that has been finished, including any touchups or additional work following initial healing and the client is released from service") https://www.oregon.gov/oha/PH/HLO/Pages/Board-Body-Art-Practitioners-Tattoo-Artists-License.asp × (Training Required)
