Questions for Personal Reflection & Group Discussion

Read Galatians 5:16, 22-23.

How might your life be different if you more intentionally chose to let the Holy Spirit guide you each day?

Read Matthew 6:24.

Why do you think Jesus identified money as the second master in this verse?

Read Matthew 6:33.

What promise does Jesus make in this verse?
