Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read John 13:1-17.

What is Jesus teaching His disciples by washing their feet?
How would you respond if Jesus were to wash your feet?

2. Read John 13:31-38.

How will the world be able to identify Jesus' followers?
How would someone know that you are a follower of Jesus?

3. Read John 13:36-14:31.

What was troubling to the disciples?
What are some things that trouble you? Why?

How did Jesus make Heaven real to the disciples?

Does looking forward to Heaven help to calm you when your heart is anxious? Why or why not?

What does Jesus say about what it means to know the Father?
Would you say you know the Father? Explain your answer.

In verses 12-15, what conditions for answered prayer does Jesus give?
What does it mean to ask in Jesus' name?

What does this passage teach you about the Holy Spirit?

How can the Holy Spirit help you?

How have you experienced His presence in your life?

In what area of your life do you need more of His presence and power?

In verses 19 thru 24, Jesus connects love and obedience. Why do you think Jesus emphasized this?

How has your love for Jesus motivated you to obey Him?

As you walk in obedience, how have you felt the love of the Father?

How is the peace that Jesus gives different from the peace the world offers?

In what ways has Jesus given you peace? How is your life different because of it?
