## Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

### 1. Read John 18:1-6.

How does Jesus identify Himself to those who have come for Him? How has Jesus revealed Himself to you?

### 2. Read John 18:7-11.

Have you ever found yourself in a position to defend a friend? What did you do?

How did Peter attempt to defend Jesus? What mistakes did Peter make? In what ways do you see yourself in Peter?

### 3. Read Matthew 16:15-16 and John 18:12-27.

Compare the words of Peter in Matthew 16 and his words in John 18. What changed?

Imagine being in Peter's shoes around that fire. How do you think you would have responded?

How might you strengthen your faith in order to stand firm and faithful under pressure?

### 4. Read John 19:1-16.

What do you learn from the way Jesus interacted with the various 'authorities' that can help you in dealing with a hostile and unjust world?

How will you apply that truth to your life this week?
