Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read John 20:1-18.

What do you learn about Peter and John in verses 2-10?

Why do you think John mentions the graveclothes? Why are they important?

Why is it significant that Jesus chose to appear first to a woman and entrusted her with the task of taking the message that He had risen to the disciples?

With whom do you most identify in this passage? Peter, John, or Mary? Why?

How does the resurrection free us from the fear of death? What impact does that have on your day-to-day life?

2. Read John 20:19-31.

What phrase does Jesus repeat in these verses? Why do you think He says it three times?

What role does evidence play in your conviction that Jesus rose from the dead?

In what ways has your life been transformed by Jesus?

Why did John write his gospel (vs 31)?

3. Read John 21:1-25.

Why do you think Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved Him?

What significance is there in Jesus' providing the disciples with a meal of fish and bread? What truths is He reminding them of?

What have been the most significant truths you've learned in this study of John?

In what ways are you allowing the Word of God (Jesus) to transform your life?

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
