2. Read John 15:9-10.

Jesus sums up all of the Jewish laws with one command. What is it?

What does it look like to live out that command in a romantic relationship?

3. Read John 15:12-13.

What do you think it means to "lay down your life" for a friend? Sometimes those who are closest to us get the worst of us rather than sacrificial love. How could you live out this greatest love this week?

List three things that come to mind when you think about God's love for you. What would it look like for you to extend those same things to someone else?
