Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Ephesians 2:1-3.

How does Paul describe those who do not follow Jesus in these verses?

Are you, as a follower of Jesus, more alive than the unbelievers you know? If so, in what ways?

2. Read Ephesians 2:4-7.

Why are the words “But God” so significant?

What does the word ‘mercy’ mean? Use a dictionary, if needed. How has God’s mercy impacted you?

Why did God make us alive?

How does God make dead people come alive?

How is your life different today, as a follower of Jesus, than it was before you surrendered your life to Him?

3. Read Ephesians 2:8-9

What does the word ‘grace’ mean? Use a dictionary, if needed. How has God’s grace impacted you?

What is the relationship between grace and works?

4. Read Ephesians 2:10.

What does it mean that you are God’s workmanship or masterpiece?

What good work is God giving you to do, with His power, this week?
