Questions for Personal Reflection & Group Discussion

Read Isaiah 45:3

How do you feel about being in the dark? What memories or emotions does it stir up for you?

What promise does God make in this verse? Why do you think He makes this promise?

Read Job 23:10.

What hope does this verse offer you when facing difficulty or hard times? In what ways might God be testing you?

What do you think the phrase “come forth as gold” means? What might that look like in your own life?

Read Habakkuk 3:17-19.

Habakkuk lists several difficult circumstances through which he will still have faith. Write out your own list of challenges through which you will still choose to trust God.

What responses, even in hardship, does Habakkuk choose? How have you responded to loss, grief, and pain in the past. How might you respond differently after going through this study?

Read Psalm 23:4

What testimony do you have of God's presence during a time of darkness in your life?

How do past experiences of God giving you treasure in the darkness encourage you as you go through dark times now?

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
