Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. *Read 2 Peter 2:1-22.*

As you read through this chapter, write down all the things Peter says the false teachers will do or that will happen because of them.

In this chapter, Peter provides us with several examples of those who turned away from God to go their own ways. What examples did he give and what happened in each of them?

How does our world today compare to the world of Noah or Sodom and Gomorrah?

Why do you think people, even those who claim to follow Jesus, fall for false teaching? What is so attractive about it?

What places in your own thinking or beliefs have been influenced by the ideas or value systems of worldly (ungodly) thinking? In what ways?

How does Peter describe the false teachers (verses 12-22)?

How would you define freedom? What kind of freedom do the false teachers promise? What kind of freedom does Jesus promise?

How can you make sure that you are not falling prey to twisted truth?

In what ways is your daily living out of alignment with Jesus? Is there something other than Christ that has a controlling influence in your life?

What do you need to do to live a life that is more consistent with the truth of God's Word? When will you make that change?
